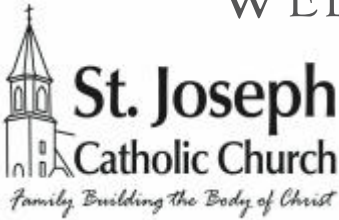

STORIES OF "EUCHARISTIC" CONVERSIONS

Having watched "The Journey Home" on EWTN on Monday night for many years, I have heard dozens of stories of how former atheists, agnostics, Muslims, Protestants, etc. have been wooed into the Catholic Church by the mystery of the Eucharist. The National Catholic Register featured an article by Roxanne King on July 14, 2021, entitled "Catholic Converts Tell Their Story of Eucharistic Reckoning". Today, I want to share the story of Sonja Corbitt known as the "Bible Study Evangelista". Some of you may recall hearing her speak at the Central Arkansas Magnificat Meal a few years ago.

While still a Southern Baptist Corbitt began studying the Protestant Reformation after experiencing two traumatic church splits in her small country church. When she read "the Bread of Life Discourse" in John 6:22-59, this time in light of the teaching of the Catholic Church, she was convinced that the Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ as the Church has taught from the very beginning.

As a Baptist, Corbitt had long desired and prayed for a way to become closer to Christ. She quickly realized that her prayer had been answered when she discovered the truth and mystery of the Eucharist. Corbitt wasted no time when she entered the Church at the Easter vigil in 2006.

"The Journey Home" tells stories about converts who often begin their journey home by delving into early Church history which they have never been exposed to and are gradually led to the undeniable truth of the Eucharist. I encourage you to tune in Monday nights at 7 PM and be inspired by their passionate witness.



The Eucharist is the Key

In His passion, Jesus took upon himself the sins of the world in order to take them away: the mystery of redemption through suffering. The Eucharist makes present Jesus' love unto death, His love that is more powerful than sin and death. The Eucharist is the key to our Catholic faith; it feeds our souls.

In Adoration, we can worship Jesus bodily present in the Blessed Sacrament even outside of Mass.

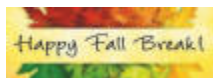

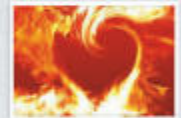


