CHRISTMAS GIFT TO YOURSELF ATTENDING WEEKDAY MASS

Today, I invite each of you to give yourself one more gift, the One that keeps on giving of Himself in every Eucharist. This is not about making a New Year's resolution. Rather it is an opportunity to begin a new spiritual discipline that will pay big dividends at any time of the year. There are many good spiritual disciplines you may already be doing with prayer, devotions, scripture reading, and studying Catholic teachings, etc. While these are all to be encouraged, a weekday Mass could be the next gift you give yourself in your faith formation.

I speak from my own weekday Mass experience which started slowly and intermittently seven or eight years ago. As my circumstances changed (an empty nest and retirement), so did my level of commitment. Today, I am able to attend a few weekday Masses each week. This number may not be possible for many of you who are still working or have a growing family. However, it may be possible for you to participate in at least one of the daily Masses which are offered at different times Monday through Friday and on the First Saturday of each month. There are also many funerals with the Mass of Christian Burial which we the faithful are encouraged to attend as one of the Corporal Works of Mercy.

You may find, as I have, a greater level of intimacy with the Eucharistic Lord in these weekday Masses which are celebrated in the quietness, stillness, and smaller space of the Adoration Chapel. You may also grow in your appreciation of more frequent Confession which happens every Tuesday and Thursday before the 6 PM Mass and on Saturdays at 8 AM. Give yourself the greatest gift in heaven and on earth by coming, tasting, and seeing the goodness of the Lord up close and personal.

Imagine how much more joyful our families would be if we covered them with regular prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament, or adored together as a family. La Epifanía del Señor

Aun en estos tiempos, la humanidad continúa buscando la estrella, esa estrella que muchas veces se pierde entre la injusticia, el odio y la discriminación. Sin embargo, hay que seguir el camino y alzar los ojos al cielo para encontrar el centro de su luz. “Levántate y brilla, que ha llegado tu luz y la Gloria de Yavé amaneció sobre ti (Isaías 60,1). La Gloria de la Manifestación de Jesús en su Evangelio y en la Eucaristía se hace presente entre nosotros en la Liturgia de hoy. El Papa Francisco nos explica acerca de la belleza de esta celebración. “La manifestación de Jesús, simbolizada por la luz: Levántate y resplandece, Jerusalén, porque llega tu luz; la Gloria del Señor amanece sobre ti”. Él nos exhorta al movimiento, a no quedarnos ahí fijos como estatuas sin hacer nada.

También, nos explica sobre la participación de los magos del Oriente y lo que ellos representan. “Los Magos, venidos de Oriente, representan a todos los pueblos lejanos de la fe judía tradicional: se dejan guiar por la estrella y se enfrentan a un largo y arriesgado viaje; se postran ante Jesús y le ofrecen regalos simbólicos: oro, incienso y mirra; la búsqueda del Señor implica también la generosidad del corazón” (1/6/2019). ¿Qué le estoy ofreciendo a Jesús en esta etapa de mi vida? ¿Qué tipo de manifestaciones he tenido de Dios a lo largo de mi vida? Pidamos, en esta Eucaristía, que la luz de Cristo se manifieste en estos tiempos turbulentos y oscuros que experimentamos en el mundo entero. Sigamos vigilantes, caminemos por sendas nuevas, sigamos el ejemplo de los Magos. Ellos, regresaron a su país por otro camino.
