



Summary of November 2021 Pastoral Council Meeting

Financial Report: There was none in November, but financials for the past three months will be presented at the January meeting.

Education and Formation: Father Brian expressed enthusiasm for cooperation between St. Joseph School and the South Conway County School District through the offering of courses through Virtual Arkansas. This will allow St. Joseph students to enroll virtually in classes that aren't offered here. For example, if a student wanted to study French they could do so requesting a study hall period and take the class virtually during that time.

Stewardship Commission: The new collection envelopes will be mailed out soon. The changes in printing companies could save the parish \$2,000 or more. They'll still go out monthly for the time being but could shift to every two months.

Hispanic Commission: Preparations were underway for Our Lady of Guadalupe celebration on December 12. This included downtown process to the church and meal later that afternoon. It was decided not to have the traditional Christmas Posadas in homes to avoid possible exposure to COVID.

Old Business: There was discussion of request before Finance Council regarding fund drive to build new Catholic Campus Ministry building. That campaign has a \$3,000,000 goal. CCM is seeking support from the parish and was given permission to address their efforts at Mass. The Finance and Pastoral Councils ultimately agreed to pledge \$125,000 over five years in support of CCM's goal.

New Business: A question came up about synod in the Diocese of Little Rock. Synod means "journey together" and the questioner wanted to know what information might be coming? The purpose of the synod, according to Bishop Taylor, is to "help us be more inclusive as we look to our future as Church, and that we pay special attention to those on the margins whose concerns and perspective are so often overlooked. The three touchstones of this process are communion, participation and mission." The Bishop went on to say that Arkansas' participation in the synod will consist of a series of meetings between now and April in order reflect on how this "journeying together" happen in our local churches and what steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in journey together?

Pastor's Report: Father Tony essentially said he was very glad to be back after some vacation, which included attending a conference in New Orleans, which led to him being quarantined for COVID. He had a rough time with it, but is fine now and is looking forward to many good things happening.

HOW TO GIVE AND RECEIVE THE GREATEST ACT OF LOVE By Kathy Kordsmeier

In this new year of 2022 AD let us ask ourselves; How can I show more reverence and respect for Jesus in the Eucharist?" Bishop Joseph Strickland of Tyler Texas says "receiving the Eucharist is the greatest act of love in the world". If this is so, how should we approach Jesus in the Eucharist? First of all, Bishop Strickland emphasizes exactly what the Church teaches, that Christ must be received in a state of holiness. The Lord invites each of us to receive him in the sacrament: "Take this and eat it, all of you". However, responding to so holy a moment should give us pause to properly prepare ourselves. This requirement is spelled out in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC)1415: "Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharistic communion must be in a state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance." In addition, CCC 1387 teaches us the importance of fasting one hour before Communion and to guard our bodily demeanor including our gestures and how we dress. The Bishop reminds us that the world largely dismisses the notion of sin or the need to turn from sin and repent. Yet this is precisely what we as Catholics are expected to do to remain in full communion with the Church. Therefore, it is necessary to have a well-formed conscience based on the teachings of the Church to ensure that we are in a state of holiness. Refer to CCC 1854-1864 for a clear explanation on "The Gravity of Sin: Mortal and Venial Sin". There are several helps available for a thorough examination of conscience to be found in the Church and online to prepare us for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Three of the great graces of the Eucharist are the wiping away of venial sins, strengthening us to resist temptation, and preserving us from future mortal sins. Therefore, the more we receive Jesus worthily in Communion, the more likely we are to be properly disposed to receive Him the next time. There is no greater act of love!




