## WHY THE SABBATH?

As Catholics we are taught that attending Sunday Mass is an obligation and one of the five precepts of the Church, but what does it mean to keep holy the Sabbath? Mark Hart helps us understand the connection in his book *Behold the Mystery: A Deeper Understanding of the Catholic Mass*. Let's begin with the root of the word Sabbath which means seventh day.

"Sabbath" comes from the Hebrew word "sheba" based on the word seven and meaning swearing an oath or a covenant. Hart defines a covenant as "a sacred, familial bond between God and man or between people." It becomes a total exchange of self which teaches us how to give and receive love. We know that God entered into a covenant with Adam and Eve on the seventh day after their creation which we read in Genesis 2: 3, "So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all his work which he had done in creation."

Today God's people are placed within the new covenant through the Mass, born out of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. We are invited into a natural rhythm of not only rest, but also praise, worship and intimacy with our Creator who desires to spend time with us. How do we renew our Sabbath covenant? Does our weekend revolve around sports and activities or do we rest, pray, laugh, and be present to our loved ones? After the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, how else do we set this day apart from every other day of the week? Does God get our best or what is left over after we clean the house and mow the yard? Do we pray outside of Mass and grace before meals and as a family? Do we share our brokenness, fears and sins with God, or only our wants and needs?

Mark Hart reminds us that Sunday is meant to prepare us for eternity, not just for the week ahead. Are we ready?

La Iglesia tiene diversidad de carismas, donde podemos entregarnos al servicio de los demás.

Por ejemplo, hoy el Evangelio nos invita a participar junto con María y Jesús en las bodas de Caná. Y es ahí en esa boda, donde Jesús hace su primer milagro a petición de su Madre María. El diálogo de ambos viene a ser a causa de la falta de vino. Por lo tanto, los novios estaban en apuros por esta razón. Este relato es muy profundo, el hecho de que Jesús participa en la boda, tiene como significado la boda de Dios con la humanidad, que más adelante será la Sangre de Jesús derramada para la salvación de la humanidad. "Alegrémonos, regocijémonos démosle honor y gloria, porque han llegado las bodas del Cordero" (Apocalipsis 19,7). También, el profeta en la primera lectura lo pone claro: "No te llamaran más 'Abandonada', ni a tu tierra 'Desolada', sino que te llamen 'Mi Preferida' y a tu tierra 'Desposada'. Porque Yavé se complacerá en ti y tu tierra tendrá un esposo" (Isaías 62,4).
