SUNDAY MASS: OBLIGATION OR CHOICE?

You probably already know the answer to this question, particularly if you read last week's reflection, "Why Sabbath?". I found three additional supports for the Third Commandment in Session 4 Preparing for the Miracle of the Mass taken from Conversations: A Study Guide by The Veil Removed team who produced the powerful short film on the Eucharist by the same name. Firstly, the early Christians taught us that the Eucharist was the most important event of the week. They gathered very early in the morning, sometimes before dawn, to celebrate the Mass even before going to work. We can learn from them to put first things first. Making Sunday the "Sabbath" (to swear an oath or covenant between God and us) allows us to live our lives from one Eucharist to the next.

Secondly, since the Sabbath is a covenant the Third Commandment naturally obliges us to keep holy the Sabbath and makes missing Mass on Sunday a grave matter. Illness, serious injury, and an emergency are examples of permissible reasons to miss Mass. To miss willfully without a valid or exceptional reason is a mortal sin. If we are unsure, particularly in this time of a pandemic, we should consult our confessor and/or pastor. A mortal sin is like a mortal wound seriously damaging our souls which requires us to receive healing in the Sacrament of Penance before we can receive Holy Communion again.

Thirdly, "One of the primary effects or fruits of Holy Communion is the forgiveness of venial sins". So why do we still need to go to Confession if we are not committing mortal sins? The authors offer these reasons: "We go ...to have our souls healed. The priest stands not so much as judge. Like a doctor, ...he works to diagnose the disease. Then....he gives a penance — a prescription— not so much to make up for what has gone wrong, but to help us steel our souls to avoid it in the future. ...the graces given (in Absolution) reconcile us to God and to each other". Going regularly, at least once a month, will help us to keep track of our sins, and to always be prepared for the "Miracle of the Mass".



The Voice of Jesus

Sin separates us from one another and from God, but it also divides us interiorly, setting one part of the self against another. We have all experienced this: our minds are divided, our wills are split, and our emotions go against our deepest convictions. The authoritative voice of Jesus brings us back to true selves. When you allow his word to reach deep down within you, you get knitted

back together. When Jesus becomes the clear center of your life, then your mind, your will, your emotions, your private life, your public life—all of it—finds its harmonious place around that center. Come to adoration where you can be quiet and hear the Lord's voice in your heart. View the schedule and sign up at conway.weadorehim.com. 

La Voz de Jesús
