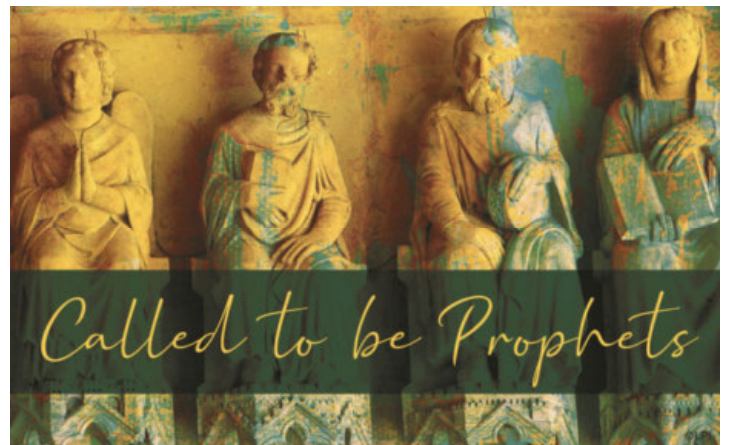
## Change a life with your spare change!

## REVEALING THE TRUTH BEHIND THE VEIL part 1

**The Veil Removed** is a short film which wonderfully reveals what happens when heaven and earth come together during the Mass. According to the producers of the video, the scenes filmed represent what has been described by several saints and mystics and revealed by scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Even if you have previously watched the 7 minute film, I encourage you to go to [www.theveilremoved.com](http://www.theveilremoved.com) to view it again while reading the rest of this reflection.

In *Conversations, A Study Guide*, published by **The Veil Removed**, Session 1 begins with a discussion titled “What’s Behind the Veil?” In Matthew 27:51, we read about a huge thick veil in the Jerusalem Temple which separated the Holy of Holies, where God dwelled, from the rest of the sanctuary. This scripture verse describes how this huge curtain was torn in two by an earthquake when Jesus died. The discussion compares this physical veil to the symbolic one that clouds our human vision from seeing what is really happening at Mass today.

**The Veil Removed** draws back this curtain so that all can see the wonder of the Mass in all its glory! As we watch the opening scene we begin to see a strange light following the lady and her toddler back into the church. Next we see the family bringing the offertory gifts to the altar with a host of angels behind them. Now there are angels everywhere, angels and other figures, probably saints, high above the altar and dark gray figures below the altar representing the souls in purgatory.

Listen to the words just before the Eucharistic Prayer which perfectly attest to what we are now witnessing, “And so, with Angels and Archangels, with Thrones and Dominions, ..... as without end we acclaim: Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of hosts, heaven and earth are full of your glory.....” Since learning this connection, I have closed my bodily eyes at this moment to see the spiritual reality of being united through time and space with the heavenly hosts, and to all Christians who have gone before me, now joined with God made flesh who is present in our time.



## The Value of our Souls

Our Lord Jesus Christ suffered and died for all men. His suffering proves that the dignity of a soul is beyond understanding—for God to sacrifice Himself, in order to save that soul and make it happy forever!

Let us learn, by the contemplation of God upon a Cross, what is the value of our souls. Let us not lose our soul; instead let us beg Jesus Christ Himself to take charge of it, to lead us

in the right way and guide us always. Come to the Adoration Chapel and worship the Lord who saves us.

Ser cristiano es ser un profeta comprometido en el amor y en la esperanza. La Liturgia de hoy, por medio del profeta Jeremías, nos pone en alerta sobre este asunto del llamado de Dios al discipulado ya desde el vientre materno: “Antes de formarte en el seno de tu madre, ya te conocía; antes de que tú nacieras, yo te consagré, y te destiné a ser profeta de las naciones” (Jeremías 1,5). Para comprender con mayor claridad y poner manos a la obra en este llamado, debemos recordar que, el domingo pasado, Jesús se encontraba en la sinagoga de Nazaret y sus últimas palabras del pasaje de la Escritura decían: “Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello” (Lucas 4,21).

Los que escuchaban a Jesús se admiraban de su elocuencia. ¡No lo podían creer! Ellos lo conocían, habían vivido a su alrededor, tenían familiaridad con él. Por lo menos sabían su oficio, “carpintero, hijo de José y María”. Jesús conocía sus pensamientos y responde: “Seguramente ustedes me van a recordar el dicho: Médico, cúrate a ti mismo. Realiza también aquí, en tu patria, lo que nos cuentan que hiciste en Cafarnaúm” (Lucas 4,23). ¿Por qué nadie es profeta en su tierra? Le pasó a Jesús y nos pasa muchas veces a nosotros, hacemos el bien por ahí y cuando se dan cuenta los vecinos y la familia, viene el cuestionamiento y los comentarios sin saber realmente lo que la persona es, vive, o siente. O, mejor dicho, se ignora su compromiso con el amor, como lo expresa San Pablo a los Corintios: “Ahora, pues, son válidas la fe, la esperanza y el amor: pero la mayor de estas tres es el amor” (1 Corintios 13,13)

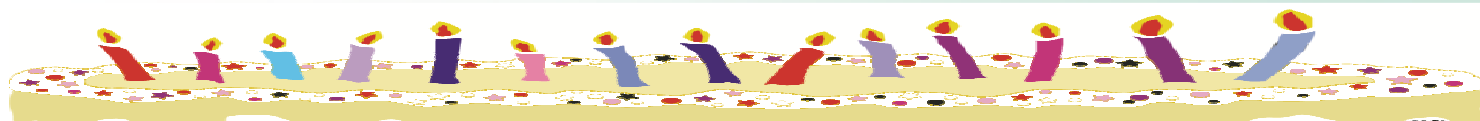
