# NEWS and UPCOMING EVENTS

#### January 2022 Pastoral Council Meeting Summary

Financial Report: Three months of collections and expenses were analyzed. The figures were relatively uneventful. The church is in a strong financial position and things are going smoothly. On-line giving has been steadily strong. With the nod of the Council, the Finance Committee gave approval to support the \$125,000 commitment to the construction of the new Catholic Campus Ministry facility near the University of Central Arkansas. The amount due on the Diocesan loan on the building of the Spiritan Center has dropped to under \$1,000,000. The debt will be helped even further by the lowering of the interest rate from 5 ½ per cent to 4. This could also help the high school with its current building project.

Education and Formation Commission: With COVID on the rise, St. Joseph School returned to masking requirements. This change will remain in effect until the numbers improve. At present, there are no plans to deviate from in-person learning. Otherwise, Principal Matt Tucker says the second semester is "off to a great start." There have been some new additions to the student body, and the school is working on a memorandum of understanding to allow SJS high school students to participate in Virtual Arkansas on-line courses not otherwise available. The church's Youth Ministry activities will resume in February after a two- month hiatus. The Ministry's gatherings will be dictated by COVID conditions. Stewardship Commission: The new contribution envelopes seem

to be working well. **Hispanic Commission:** The activities surrounding the Our Lady of Guadalupe feast day in December were all successful.

Parish Life Commission: The planned dates for Lenten Dinners are March 9, 16, and 30th. The Hispanic Commission is being asked about preparing one of these meals.

Other possibilities are pork tenderloin and gumbo. Charities that may benefit from these meals include Alzheimer's

Arkansas/JoeBear Apparel, COHO, The Call, or HAVEN. The Commission is also looking at a celebration this summer to recognize our two newly-ordained deacons. It could take place in July.

New Business: There was an extended discussion of security concerns regarding access to the Adoration Chapel. There have been incidents where homeless people or vagrants have obtained the door code or been let in and used the space to hibernate. This has understandably made some adorers uncomfortable. Changing the code was recommended, but it was also felt that wouldn't change things in the long run as long as parishioners continue giving out the code. The installation of dead bolts was ruled out due to fire laws. It was noted the church has requested increased police presence in this regard.

Pastor's Report: Father Tony said his greatest news was a new discernment from our parish regarding Elijah Bailey. He is engaged in the application process. In September of 2021, Pope Francis invited Catholics Worldwide to take part in a Synod on Synodality. It is to be a two-year process of discussion and reflection in preparation for a meeting of the Synod of Bishops to take place in October 2023. Every diocese will be holding listening sessions with a special focus on people who are marginalized in the Church. At St. Joseph's, these sessions will be held the first week in February at the Spiritan Center in both English and Spanish. Father Tony sought feedback on how the overflow during Christmas Masses was handled. Audio-visual equipment on loan from the Piraino family was set up in the Adoration Chapel and the Spiritan Center. Thought has been given to purchasing a moveable TV monitor at a cost of \$2,000 for this purpose. This idea will be discussed further at the next Pastoral Council meeting.

#### Welcome Back, Deacon Doug!

Deacon Doug and his wife Lisa have rejoined our parish after working in New York for the past 10 years. They have been married for over 40 years and have one daughter, Abby, a graduate of St. Joseph. She remains in New York serving her community as a police officer. Deacon Doug began his diaconal studies in the Diocese of Little Rock and completed his studies in the Archdiocese of New York and was ordained at Saint Patrick's Cathedral in 2016. Deacon Doug is the superintendent of schools at Vilonia and Lisa is a school psychologist in the Jacksonville North Pulaski school district.

# Prayer & Adoration

**REVEALNG THE TRUTH BEHIND THE VEIL** part 2 By Kathy Kordsmeier

Last week we examined some of the scenes of the short film at www.theveilremoved.org and learned more about what is behind the scenes from Conversation: A Study Guide. This week let's look more closely at the gray figures underneath the altar, the souls in purgatory, those who have died but are not yet ready for heaven.

From the earliest days of the church, the Mass has been offered "for the living and the dead." So what is it that brings heaven, the souls in purgatory, and all of us on earth together in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass? The Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1326 (CCC) explains that the Mass is where we are united in the heavenly liturgy in anticipation of eternal life when God will be our all in all. While we still require the signs and symbols in the Mass on earth, the liturgy in heaven has no need of signs and symbols because "what the liturgy on Earth signifies and symbolizes is the reality which we experience in Heaven."

Christ has given us his "Real Presence" on earth through the Mass. Catholics call this "Sacramental Realism" which means the sacraments actually do bring about what they say they do. Fast forward to the moment of transubstantiation in the film when the priest becomes Jesus and the blood from the cross drips into the chalice. As I watched this scene of the blood dripping from the side of the crucified Christ into the chalice at the hands of Jesus on the altar, the veil was removed to pierce my heart with what I already knew in my head. Here I beheld and absorbed these absolute truths: that the priest acts in the person of Christ; that Jesus gives us the Eucharist, His Body and Blood in every Mass; and that the Eucharist is a perpetual re-presentation of Christ's life, death, and resurrection. Let us rejoice again and again with all the saints and angels and souls in purgatory at the very thought of the Mass!




