SAINTLY REFLECTIONS ON THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

As we would expect, all the Saints in the Church have a devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. Some of their devotions have been preserved and others have not. A search of Catholic websites such as www.ewtn.org, www.catholicculture.org, and www.ourcatholicprayers.com will yield a number of these recorded devotions and prayers. Today, I want to quote a few of the saints who have articulated their esteem and love of the Eucharistic Lord.

While reading Chapter 34, "The Eucharistic Devotion of the Saints", from Eucharistic Miracles by Joan Carroll Cruz, I learned this reflection from St. Alphonsus de Liguori: Our most loving Redeemer, on the last night of His life,... had not the heart to leave us alone in this valley of tears;... He would leave us His whole self as food in the Sacrament of the Altar.

St. Teresa of Avila, expressed her lively faith in the Real Presence as she addressed these words to God: ...when I hear others say they wish they had been living when You were on earth, I laugh to myself, for I know that I possess You as truly in the Blessed Sacrament as people did then, and I wonder what more anyone could possibly want.

St. Thomas Aquinas described the Holy Eucharist as a Sacrament of love and a token of the greatest love that a God could give us. The Cure of Ars, St. John Vianney recorded these few profound words: It is the destiny of every consecrated Host to melt with love in a human heart.

Sitting with some of these words and images before the Blessed Sacrament may encourage us to seek out some Eucharistic prayers and devotions from the saints which resonate with us. Who knows, the Holy Spirit may even inspire us to write a personal prayer or reflection on our relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist. Come Holy Spirit, Come!

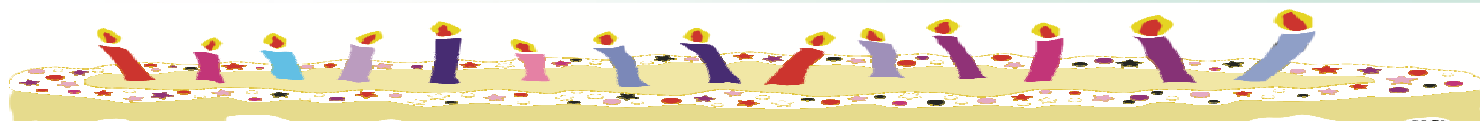
