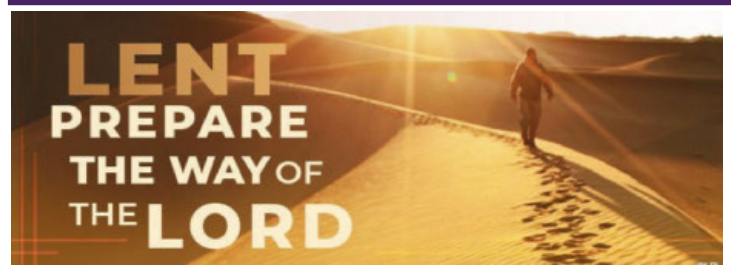

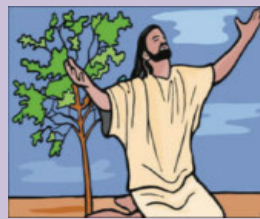

FAMILY HEIRLOOM INSPIRES THANKSGIVING AFTER COMMUNION

I have a rare 1859 edition of *St. John's Manual: A Guide to the Public Worship and Services of the Catholic Church and A Collection of Devotion for the Private Use of the Faithful*. The prayer book belonged to my Great Great Grandmother, Louisa Hall Laharanne Penfield, who was born in 1845 and died in 1921. She was a convert to the Catholic faith who entered the School Sisters of Notre Dame Convent in St. Louis Missouri on November 3, 1864, but was dismissed for health reasons prior to her marriage in 1866. Perhaps, she received this Manual while she was in the Convent. I have learned that she was a stalwart faith-filled woman who overcame much during this post-Civil War period. I am eternally grateful for her and her descendants who passed on their strong Catholic heritage to me.

Here is an introduction from the *St. John Manual* which illustrates the deep piety with which Louisa and her early Catholic descendants may have rendered thanksgiving after receiving Holy Communion. May it inspire each of us to do the same, if only for a few moments.

There is no prayer more acceptable to God and more profitable to our own souls than that which is offered in thanksgiving after Holy Communion. Christ our Saviour remains present with us until the sacramental species are consumed. During these sacred moments, we may imagine that we hear from the mouth of Jesus Christ himself these words, which he speaks formerly to his disciples: "But me ye have not always with you." (John 12:8)

It is not well immediately after communion to begin reading in a book; it is far better to pass some few moments in solitary and confidential conversation with Jesus Christ, thus kindly present in our heart, and to give silent encouragement to those emotions and desires which naturally arise.O what treasures of grace can a pious soul obtain if she converses in spirit with her beloved Jesus at least a half hour after Holy Communion!



Heartfelt Hosanna

On his entry to Jerusalem, Jesus was greeted with exultation by the crowds. We know how quickly their adoration turned to shouts for crucifixion. May we praise the Lord with heartfelt love and humility for all he has done for us. Our souls are in his hands, and he waits for us to visit him in the Holy Eucharist exposed in the Chapel.

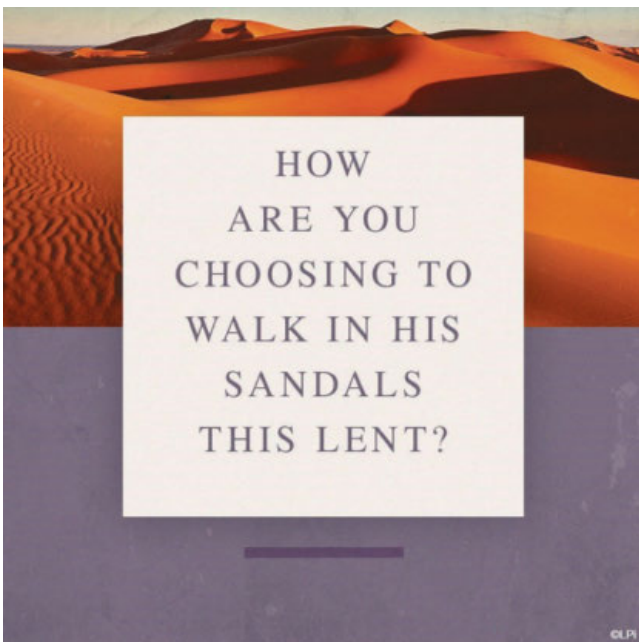



La gente le pregunta y él responde con claridad y sencillez. San Gregorio Magno (540-604. Homilía 31, 4), exhorta a las personas con una reflexión profunda sobre la higuera que no da fruto: “Con un grande temor se debe escuchar lo que se dice: Córdala. ¿Para qué ocupa la tierra inútilmente? Cada uno a su manera, si no hace buenas obras. Pero desde el momento que ocupa un espacio en la vida presente, es un árbol que ocupa inútilmente el terreno, porque en ese lugar en donde está, impide que ahí se ponga otro a trabajar”.

Continúa su homilía. “Pero hay algo más grave, y es que los poderosos de este mundo, si no realizan ningún bien, no lo hacen producir ni siquiera en aquellos que dependen de ellos, porque su ejemplo actúa sobre sus subalternos como una sombra estimulante de perversidad... Sofocados por la sombra no reciben el calor del sol y permanecen fríos, sin el calor de Dios. Pero el pensamiento de este poderoso, cualquiera que sea su nombre, no es más objeto directo de los cuidados de Dios. Dejarnos cuidar por Dios es el mensaje de Cristo. La Iglesia administra cuidadosamente los sacramentos para que sus fieles acudan a recibir el abono por medio de ellos. Los sacramentos de iniciación cristiana son la base. Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía. ¿Los frecuentas? ¿Cómo te ayudan a crecer y dar fruto en tu vida?

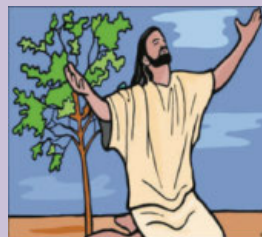

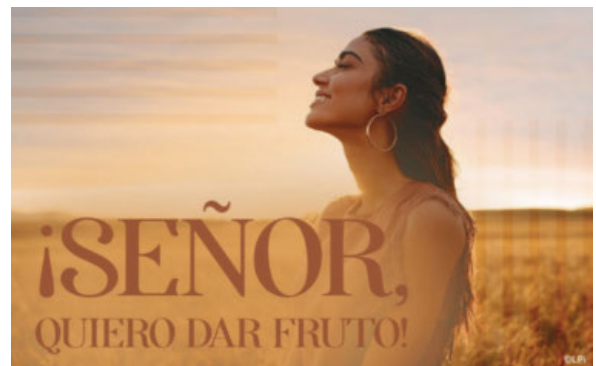


