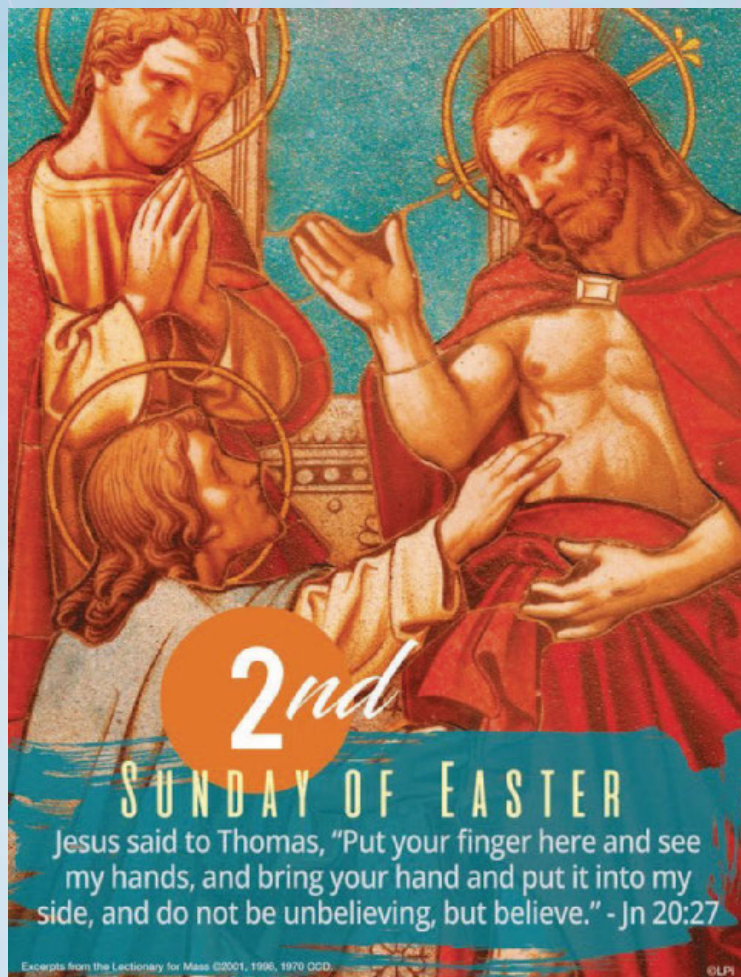

## EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL AND AD ORIENTEM (LITURGICAL EAST)

As discussed last week, the Diocese of Little Rock is participating in the call by the USCCB for a three year Eucharistic Revival. In addition, Arkansas Catholics for Eucharistic Revival (ACER) is reaching out to the faithful to renew love for Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament. ACER maintains that faith in the Real Presence has been weakened primarily by the lack of two traditional practices, Ad Orientem worship (facing Liturgical East) and kneeling to receive Holy Communion on the tongue.

First, let's consider ad orientem taken from an article by Thomas E. Woods Jr. found on [www.Catholic.com](http://www.Catholic.com). The question is asked regarding the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM), "Will the priest have his back to the congregation?" Woods responds by explaining that it is not a question of turning his back to the people, but rather understanding that the priest and the people are facing the same direction, towards Christ who will come again from the east and to whom we are directing our prayers.

Today, as most of us know, our churches may or may not face east and only in the Traditional Latin Mass are we likely to see the celebrant facing Christ on the crucifix and/or in the tabernacle, which is called liturgical east. Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger (later consecrated as Pope Benedict XVI) wrote in 2004, "... I think that celebration turned towards the east, towards the Christ who is coming, is an apostolic tradition." (Apostolic", meaning from the time of the apostles) Consider how the disposition of the priest and the person in the pew would likely change if all were turned towards Christ in prayer, especially in adoration, and thanksgiving at the highest moment of the liturgy, the Consecration and Elevation. It seems that this ancient orientation was intended to help the participant and the priest lovingly gaze upon the Eucharistic Christ while being a witness to the Redeemer's glory and majesty.

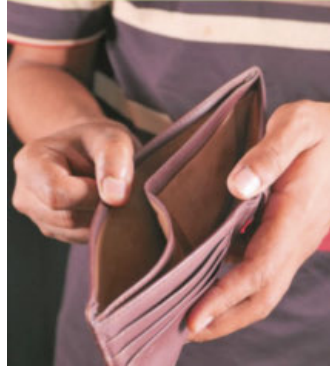

## 2º Domingo de Pascua (La Divina Misericordia)

La Liturgia de este II Domingo de Pascua celebra el Domingo de la Misericordia. El Evangelio nos dice que ocho días después se les apareció Jesús. Bridándoles su paz entonces y ahora a nosotros.
