Healing Through The Eucharist (Part 1)

I watched another excellent webinar by the Avila Institute last week by Dr. David Arias called “Eucharist: Healing with the Greatest Gift Ever!” Dr. Arias presented an hour long talk on the subject richly supported by teachings from St. Thomas Aquinas and St. Leo the Great among others. In my reflection this week and next I will do my best to share some of the profound truths I heard from these Holy and wise men.

Dr. Arias started with Mt 28:20 when Jesus commissions his disciples (and us) by saying: “And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” Aquinas teaches that Jesus remains with every creature by his “essence, knowledge, and power”. St. Leo the Great explains that Christ’s visible presence passed into the sacraments when He ascended into heaven. By these sacraments we receive sanctifying grace which does five things for us: “heals our souls; makes us will what is good; efficaciously do the good we will; persevere in what is good; and arrive at the glory of heaven.”

Unlike the other sacraments, the Holy Eucharist is both a sacrifice and a sacrament because it is offered up and it is received. It is the greatest sacrament by containing the very author of the grace, Jesus Christ. In every consecrated host there is a sweet companion. In every tabernacle Jesus is patiently waiting for us, eager to grant us favors, and yearning for our prayers.

Dr. Arias illuminates how Jesus comes to heal in Eucharistic Adoration and in Holy Communion. In Eucharistic Adoration he says there is “healing in the One before whom we come.” He sustains us in existence as we kneel before Him, the most perfect and most loving Friend we could ever have. We delight in his presence, find relief in Him from all our anxieties, and take joy in His words and deeds. Jesus repairs us and conforms us to Himself. He works to transform us into Himself through grace and charity if we are open and disposed to receive all that He offers.

Next week we will continue with Dr. Arias’ talk as he elucidates how Holy Communion is healing in “a union of man with Christ”.

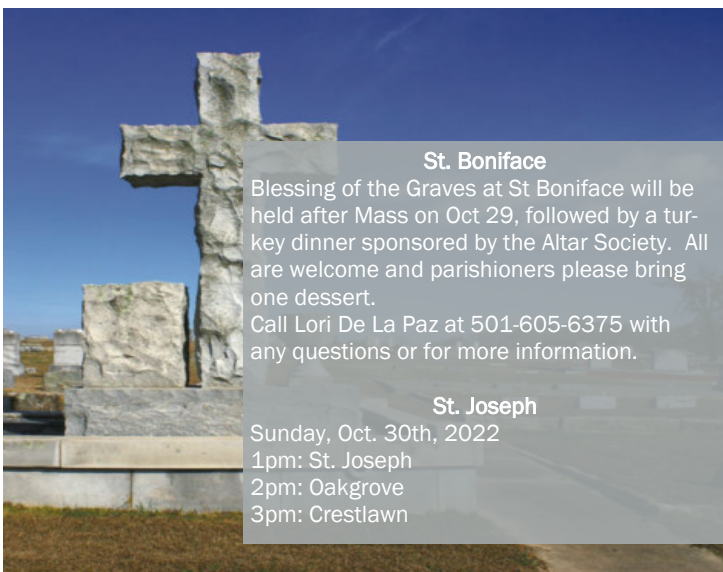

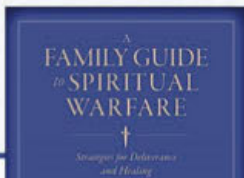

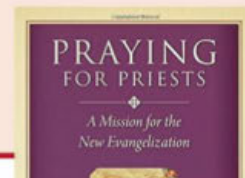
