ACCOMPANYING THE MAGI ON THEIR JOURNEY

I am currently participating in *Retreat in Daily Life* or *RIDL* as we call it. *RIDL* is a 30 week prayerful adventure based on the *Spiritual Exercises* of St. Ignatius of Loyola who was born into a noble family in Spain in 1491. The Exercises represent a journey from his head to his heart which inspired him to pursue God's greater glory and the service of others. Ignatius became convinced that the Exercises could help other people, religious and lay alike, to draw closer to God while discerning God's call in their lives.

During this 12th week of *RIDL* I have been contemplating the Birth of Jesus and praying for the grace to know Jesus more intimately, to love him more intensely, and to follow him more closely. In the Exercises, contemplation refers to using our God-given imagination in prayer. We do this by using all of our senses to enter into the Gospel story imagining the details of the scene. On Day 4 of this week, I read Matthew 2:1-12, the story of the Magi. In my contemplation I placed myself with the three wise men from the East as they first saw the star, arrived in Jerusalem seeking the newborn King of the Jews. Later I prayed and journaled what I experienced:

My Newborn King,

Surely, these astrologists from the Orient must have already acquired the grace I am praying for in order to set out in haste on such an arduous journey to an unknown place to pay You homage.

I can only begin to imagine the hardships and obstacles they encountered along the way. They had to be far greater than any that I have experienced during my comfortable life in the 21st century. I come before You now prepared to overcome whatever is necessary to follow You more closely by glorifying You as King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Wonderful Counselor, Prince of Peace, Mighty God, Everlasting Father. I thank You and praise You for the gifts You have given me by Your Incarnation. Because You came down to earth I can seek you in the stillness, in the silence, and in the Sacraments, especially in the Most Holy Eucharist. You are Emmanuel, God with us, forever and ever. Amen.

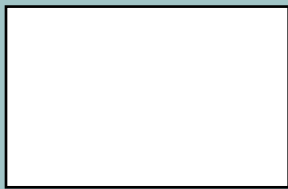

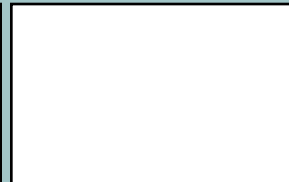
