



PRAYER & ADORATION

POPE BENEDICT XVI AND HIS EUCHARISTIC LEGACY By Kathy Kordsmeier

It seems that I am learning much more about this Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI since his death than I ever knew during his life. I suppose that is true of many of us even as it relates to family and friends. Perhaps, that is one reason I love to go to memorial services, visitations, and funerals. I am never disappointed in what I experience about the deceased by watching the video of their lives or listening to the witness of those who knew them well.

I was especially excited to find this reflection by Dr. Tim O'Malley which speaks of the late Holy Father as a champion of the Eucharist. His three part series can be read in the Heart of the Revival Newsletter (January 25, 2023) available from the National Eucharistic Revival website). Today, I offer this as a summary of part 1 which is based on Benedict's document, Sacramentum Caritatis (The Sacrament of Charity).

First, we look at his introduction to discover "how the Eucharist is a mystery to be believed". Benedict says the Eucharist is not just another religious practice imposed on Catholics. No, he says the Eucharist "is instead the privileged way that the Church encounters the mystery of love in Jesus Christ." God is love and it is through the mystery of the Eucharist that He dwells within us and among us. By giving Himself to us in this sacrament, Christ lovingly and continually builds us up as His body which is the Church. The Church herself, in faith, celebrates and adores Christ present in the Eucharist because He first gave himself to her in His sacrifice on the

O'Malley breaks this down for the reader on a personal level. He contends that he goes to Mass not because he wants to be together with like-minded people, but because God dwells among us in the diversity of all humanity. Each one of us who believes this truth is called to walk with our neighbors sharing the love of Christ. Only when we have let ourselves be loved by God and been nourished at His table, can we love others in turn. Perhaps, infusing this heart knowledge is the ultimate goal of the **National Eucharistic Revival**. Next week we look at how the Eucharist is a mystery to be celebrated.


