

# Mission Committee Devotion

Welcome to St. Joseph Mission Committee Monthly Devotion. The intent of this devotion is to offer a monthly refection and call to action for the members of our wonderful parish. The committee is overwhelmingly thankful for the generosity of our parish whose gifts reflect the heart of the people and most importantly the generosity of our Lord's grace.

Karol Wojtyla (1920-2005) noted personalist philosopher, who was blessed to become our Pope Saint John Paul II from 1978 -2005, committed himself to the affirmation of the dignity and worth of human beings. Human beings created in the image of God who are called to full fellowship in the life of our generous God. Wojtyla identifies the moral actions of a person cultivate experiences of growth in him or herself. The human experience is a combination of an individual acting and acting upon another. The person discovers the core of who he or she is by freely acting in accordance with truth and the reality of our world.

This year as you attend Mass, participate in prayer, or attend your schooling, reflect on the dignity you possess as a human being created in the image of God. The capacity you possess to act in manners which correspond to truth can have significant ramifications on the growth of your religious life and equally shape how you view men and women who are experiencing the most difficult of circumstances. Our beloved Pope Saint John Paul II reminds our parish of a significant truth regarding our existence as human beings and prayerfully, I hope this truth would stir each of member to act in ways which demonstrate growth in the Catholic faith and the promotion of generosity to those less fortunate in our parish and city.

# PRAYER & ADORATION

# POPE BENEDICT XVI AND HIS EUCHARISTIC LEGACY, PT. 2 By Kathy Kordsmeier

Last week we examined Part 1 of a series by Dr. Tim O'Malley which presented "how the Eucharist is a mystery to be believed" according to the document Sacramentum Caritatis by Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI. This week we will look at the Eucharist as a mystery to be celebrated. As Benedict has stated the Mass is a concrete, religious practice to be celebrated, not an intellectual exercise.

However, O'Malley points out that there is the potential for division in the Church over how best to celebrate the Eucharist. The author asserts that Benedict opposed this kind of in-fighting because he thought it missed the mark, that is, what is happening in the Eucharistic mystery. He described the mystery as the coming of Jesus himself to feed us with his Body and Blood, for his people to remember and give him thanks for what he has done for us. We are "primordial creatures" who live out this mystery of love as a prayer of praise for which man is made.

Benedict quotes from Vatican II on the need for our active participation in this mystery of love when he reminds us: "...the faithful should be instructed by God's word and nourished at the table of the Lord's Body. They should give thanks to God. Offering the immaculate Victim, not only through the hands of the priest but also together with him, they should learn to make an offering of themselves. Through Christ, the Mediator, they should be drawn day by day into ever more perfect union with God and each other." (Sacramentum Caritatis, no. 52)

O'Malley further clarifies how we make an offering of ourselves by learning to worship in a way that reflects who we are, a mom or dad, a single person or a spouse, a friend, a plumber or a doctor. By bringing these relationships and our daily concerns to God, we can remember to place them on the Eucharistic altar when the priest exhorts us to lift up our hearts to the Lord. Only then does Eucharistic Revival occur within our hearts drawing us "into a more perfect union with God and each other."


