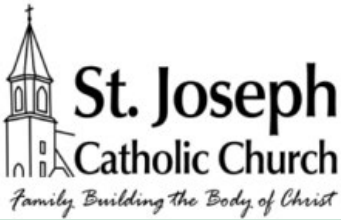

POPE BENEDICT XVI AND HIS EUCHARISTIC LEGACY, PT. 3

In Part 3 of Dr. Tim O'Malley's series on the "Eucharistic Legacy of Pope Benedict XVI," he reflects on the Eucharist as a "mystery to be lived". If we believe it is to be lived, the author invites us to ponder the question: How can we better connect our daily experiences and choices to our participation in the Eucharist? During my hour of Adoration on Saturday, I decided to spend some time contemplating this challenge.

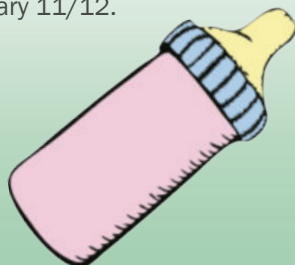
First of all, I thought about Benedict affirming that the worship of God in the Eucharist cannot be restricted to a private act by an individual. I could sense in my spirit Jesus calling me deeper. "When you receive my Body and Blood in Communion or adore Me before the Blessed Sacrament, I am bidding you to worship Me not only while you are at Mass or in the Adoration Chapel. More importantly, you must allow Me to permeate every detail of your existence, the very life I have given you."

He has made the ultimate sacrificial love offering of his life for me and I want my life to be a love offering to Him. I imagine Jesus responding: "My faithful servant Benedict has reminded you how to love as I love. Firstly, believe and testify in public places that I am truly present in the bread and wine consecrated and transubstantiated on the altar. Secondly, prove that My presence is real when you leave the sanctuary by doing works of mercy, feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, visiting the prisoner, and welcoming the stranger in your own neighborhood. Return to me the gift of your whole life shaped by the love of the God who made the first move to love you."

My Lord and my God, I promise to look for ways to meet the needs of my friends and family and strangers even when it is not convenient or I just don't feel like making the effort. There is no excuse for me not to try because you never refuse anyone the grace to take that first step, and then the next, and the next. If we ask and trust in You, we will accomplish all in cooperation with You and never alone.

La sociedad actual tiene una necesidad imperante de buscar la comodidad, la riqueza, la fama y el poder. Sin embargo, el Evangelio de hoy narra las bienaventuranzas y la primera de ellas invita a la pobreza: *“Felices los que tienen espíritu del pobre, porque de ellos es el Reino de los cielos”* (Mateo 5,3). Al contrario de esta bienaventuranza, los anuncios en los medios de comunicación son de comodidad y riqueza. Estos no se llevan con la pobreza de espíritu, mucho menos con la Buena Nueva del Evangelio, donde Dios anuncia la salvación a los pobres y va con los pobres. El sermón del monte declara solemnemente el anuncio de la Buena Nueva a los pobres y necesitados. Si analizamos a los santos y santas de Dios, ellos se caracterizan por ser pobres, justos y sencillos. *¿Cuál de las bienaventuranzas te ayuda a cambiar el corazón y te lleva a la conversión?*

Estas palabras pronunciadas por los Reyes Magos resuenan en el corazón de cada persona que hace una visita a la capilla de adoración. La presencia de Nuestro Señor en el Santísimo Sacramento es tan real hoy como lo fue el niño Jesús para los tres reyes magos. Dile a Jesús: “Soy tuyo, y te pido, por favor, quédate conmigo siempre”.

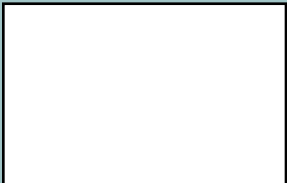
