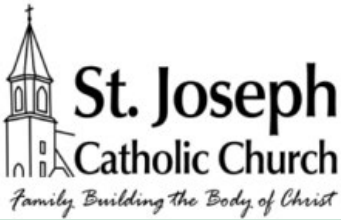

PREPARING FOR MASS BY CONFESSING OUR SINS

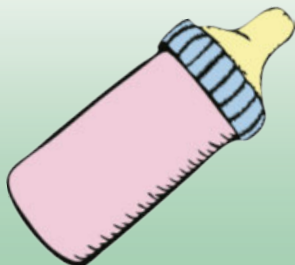
In an interview with Bishop David L. Ricken of Green Bay Wisconsin, Colleen R. Schena writes “Reigniting Your Eucharistic Faith” for the *Heart of the Revival Newsletter* (January 25, 2023). Bishop Ricken has instituted a call to worship in his diocese which he titles *Encountering Jesus in the Eucharist*. This pastoral letter introduces the “Five Alive Practices to Live the Mass” which he refers to as “five crucial pillars to cultivating a Eucharistic faith”. Confession is one of these pillars which Bishop Ricken addresses so that many who do not understand what the Church teaches may come to more fully appreciate the reality of the Mass. He begins by reminding us that since the earliest days of Christianity, believers have been preparing for Mass by first confessing our sins. This instruction is contained in the Didache (**Did-ah-key**) which is considered the first catechism written by the early Church Fathers in the second century. It states “But every Lord’s day gather yourselves together, and break bread, and give thanksgiving, after having confessed your transgressions, that your sacrifice may be pure”.

The second of the five precepts of the Church states “You shall confess your sins at least once a year.” The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) in paragraph 2042 further explains that this precept “ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism’s work of conversion and forgiveness.” Bishop Ricken, as do most spiritual advisors, recommends that we consider making a habit of going to confession once a month if we desire to grow in holiness

If you have fallen away from the regular reception of reconciliation, I encourage you to seek out a priest with whom you are comfortable to begin your return to confession. Through frequent confession I have become more aware of how sin separates me from God, found strength to overcome temptation, and grown deeper in my relationship with a loving and forgiving Jesus in the Eucharist. Remember that our Redeemer stands waiting for us with open arms through the ministry of his priests as if we are the only person He suffered and died for.

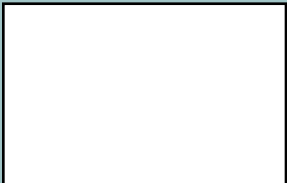
