

# PRAYER & ADORATION

# EARLY CHURCH FATHERS' WRITINGS ON THE REAL PRESENCE

I was recently loaned a book called *Behold, It Is I: Scripture, Tradition, and Science on the Real Presence* by Stacy Trasancos, PhD, and Father George Elliott. In the Foreword Bishop Joseph E. Strickland of Tyler Texas affirms that this three pronged approach to an examination of the Real Presence encompasses the entirety of our Catholic faith. However, Bishop Strickland continues by cautioning the reader and believer that ultimately the Eucharist remains mystery as it should.

For this reason, we read in the Introduction that the theological virtue of faith is necessary for proving Catholic doctrine including the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Proof must begin with belief (faith) in the teaching and revelation of Jesus Christ on earth. Apologetics is founded on the premise that these teachings are based on reason derived from Divine Revelation and its aim is to disprove the impossibility of the doctrine in question.

For our purposes in this reflection and over the next two or three weeks we will concentrate on the writings of the early Church Fathers which provides further evidence to support the inspired Word of God. All of these men were theologians and later saints who learned directly from the apostles or their disciples. They are considered to be reliable teachers because of their proximity to Jesus in place and time. Of course, we can also trust their writings because we believe the Holy Spirit preserves the teachings of Jesus throughout history.

Next week we will start with the writings of St. Ignatius, Bishop of Antioch, who lived in the latter part of the first century, followed by St. Justin Martyr who was born into a pagan family around the year 100 AD. After Justin comes St. Irenaeus of Lyons born in Smyrna (modern day Turkey) around 130 AD. Finally, we will examine the teachings of St. Cyril of Jerusalem who succeeded St. Maximus as bishop of Jerusalem in 350 AD. As we examine the work of each of these Church Fathers we will discover they are all compatible with the Church's teachings on the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.


