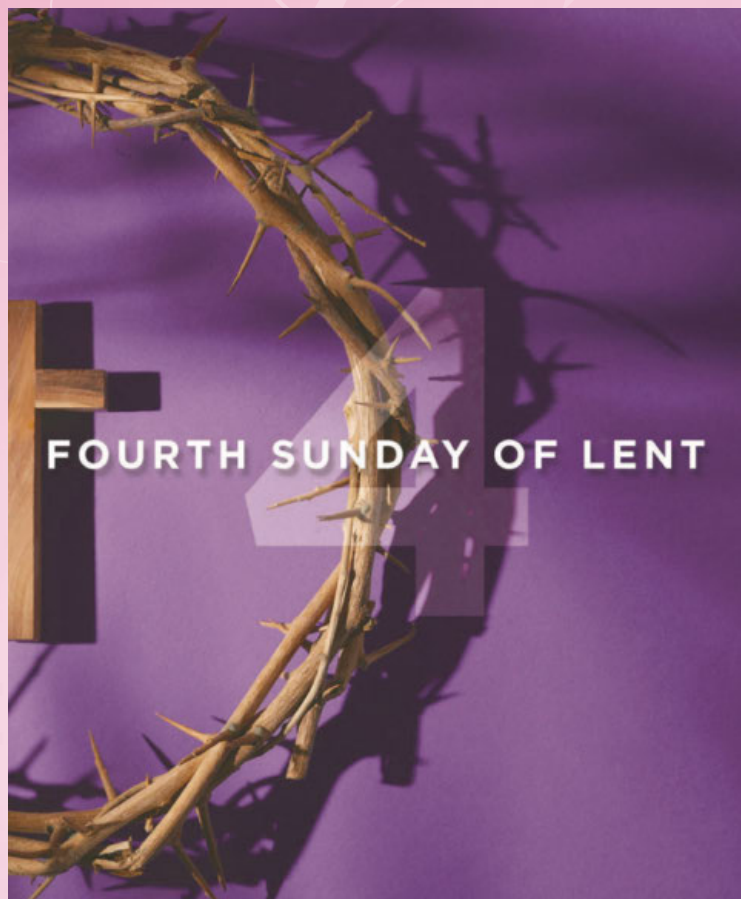

ST. CYRIL OF JERUSALEM: LECTURE ON THE REAL PRESENCE

Continuing our look at the Eucharist in the book, *Behold, it Is I*, we turn to the fourth and final early Church Father, St. Cyril of Jerusalem for his contribution. Cyril lived and wrote in the fourth century, over 150 years after St. Irenaeus. Despite the lapse of so much time between these two theologians, we learn from Cyril that the teachings on the Eucharist remained the same. For proof of this continuity the authors refer the reader to a famous series of lectures to catechumens and to the newly baptized which Cyril gave just before he became the bishop of Jerusalem in AD 347.

In one of these lectures Cyril comments on Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians 11:23 which gives an account of the words Jesus used in the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Paul begins by reminding his listeners to trust God's word when he declared at the last Supper, "This is My Body" and "This is My Blood." If Jesus himself said it, "who shall dare to doubt any longer"; "who shall ever hesitate."

Next, Cyril cites the miracle at Cana as evidence that Jesus has the power to transform one thing into something else as he did the water into wine at the wedding feast. Theologically, Cyril also instructs the listener to consider that if Jesus gave wine to these guests at a wedding, how much more fitting that he should give his Body and Blood to the Church whom he calls his Bride.

Cyril goes on to address the reality of the Body and Blood in the Eucharist as it pertains to the species of bread and wine. To refute some of Jesus' detractors who thought he was inviting them to eat flesh, Cyril further explains they lacked the 'spiritual sense' to understand. By 'spiritual' he does not mean 'not real' or merely figurative. Herein, Cyril is referring to the phenomenon that what man's senses perceive to be bread and wine is actually the Body and Blood of Christ.

In conclusion, let us know and believe that we can be with Christ, "personally and physically, in every Mass where we taste and see with the eyes of faith," the same burning faith of these early Church Fathers.

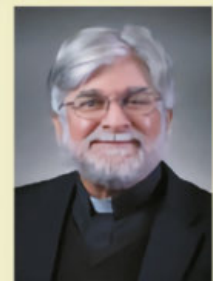

4º Domingo de Cuaresma

El Señor nos llena de luz por medio de la curación del ciego de nacimiento y nos ayuda con su milagro a estar bien preparados para llegar a la Pascua. Dentro de poco estaremos celebrando el Domingo de Ramos, para luego entrar a la Semana Santa. La fe viva se manifiesta en nuestro corazón y la entrega generosa que durante la Cuaresma hemos vivido por medio del ayuno, la oración y la caridad, se agranda para celebrar las fiestas de la Pascua.

El Papa Francisco recordó que este IV Domingo de Cuaresma es conocido como “el domingo Laetare, es decir, Alégrate”. Por esa razón, la liturgia eucarística inicia con la invitación a la alegría. “Alégrate, Jerusalén, y todos ustedes los que la aman, reúnanse. Regocíjense con ella todos los que participaban de su duelo y quedarán saciados con la abundancia de sus consue-

los” (Ver Isaías 66,10-11). Además, agregó: “Este mensaje gozoso es el corazón de la fe cristiana: el amor de Dios ha encontrado la cima en el don del Hijo a una humanidad débil y pecadora. Quien camina en la luz, quien se acerca a la luz, no puede hacer nada más que obras buenas. 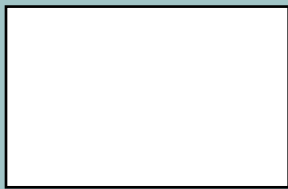

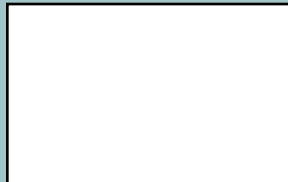

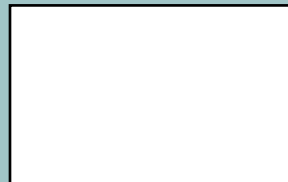
