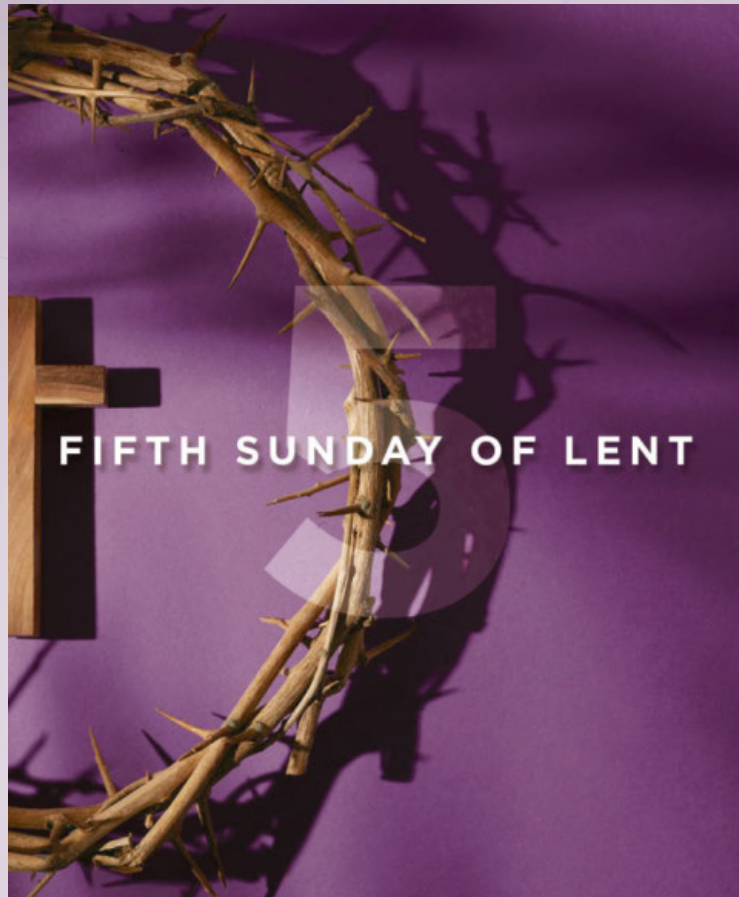

DO I THIRST FOR HIM AS HE THIRSTS FOR ME?

Jesus said, 'I thirst' (John 19:28). These are the words that would be heard in his final minutes hanging on the cross. We know that Jesus was misunderstood by the soldiers who offered him wine in response. How do we understand his real message, "I thirst for you"? Sister Alicia Torres, F.E., the Managing Editor of the *Heart of Revival* newsletter invites us to relate these words to how Jesus offers us living water in the Eucharist. Have you read that man can survive only three months without water? Sister wonders if that short life is also true of our spirits without the frequent reception of his Body and Blood. Another common image of the Eucharist further illustrates our utter dependence on the Most Blessed Sacrament. "As the mother pelican pierces her own flesh to nourish her young with her blood, Jesus allowed himself to be pierced by nails and a lance so that he could wash away our sins and nourish us with his own lifeblood."

Sister Torres introduces us to Erika in "Longing for the Sacred Banquet (March 6, 2023 newsletter)." She first met Erika, a devout lady in her 70s, at a daily Mass. Sister observed her elderly friend's palpable love for Jesus every morning when she arrived early for Mass to prepare herself for the sacred mysteries she was about to encounter in the person of Jesus. When Erika experienced the friendship of young seminarians she selflessly shared her 'widow's mite' to support them in their formation. Many of us probably know and love someone like Erika in our parish. I see the elderly, families, college students, married and singles, etc. who are faithful daily communicants and others of all ages who spend countless hours in the chapel before the Blessed Sacrament. I thank God for the example they are to me by their perseverance and humble dependence on Jesus.

In closing let us pray as St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta invites us to in "I Thirst for You." 'Jesus is God, therefore His love, His Thirst, is infinite. He, the Creator of the universe, asked for the love of His creatures. He thirsts for our love. These words: 'I thirst'—do they echo in our souls?' **How do we respond?**

5° Domingo de Cuaresma

"El que está vivo y cree en mí, dice el Señor, no morirá para siempre" (Juan 11,26). Este es el séptimo y último milagro de Jesús en el Evangelio de Juan; como pasó con la samaritana, el diálogo se ve truncado a cada momento porque Jesús retoma las palabras dándoles un significado diferente (Comentario Biblia Latinoamérica edición revisada 2005). Martha y María, amigas de Jesús, estaban muy tristes por la muerte de su hermano Lázaro. Ellas pensaban que, si Jesús hubiese estado presente, él no habría muerto. Sin embargo, Lázaro murió para que el Hijo de Dios fuera glorificado. ¿Crees esto? ¿Qué piensas exactamente de la resurrección?

La respuesta de Jesús sobre la vida y la muerte va más allá y afirma: "Yo soy la resurrección y la vida. El que cree en mí, aun-

que muera, vivirá. El que vive, el que cree en mí, no morirá para siempre" (Juan 11,25). Que más claridad se puede tener, la convicción de la vida eterna es cuestión de fe no de convencimientos. Ahora, ya se acerca la pasión del Señor, que lo llevará a la muerte en la cruz, y se prepara para su gloriosa resurrección. Terminaremos la Cuaresma con la esperanza que todas las acciones buenas durante ese tiempo hayan sido realizadas con amor hacia cada miembro de la familia y comunidad. Que no sea una Cuaresma más, sino que se salga fuera de las tumbas del egoísmo y se luche incansablemente por una sociedad mejor.
