WATER IS STRANGELY ABSENT, or at least not as abundant, as we celebrate Easter this year.

We'll bless water and be sprinkled with water to remind us of that first dousing at Baptism, but it won't come from our magnificent font, usually flowing and ample with water. After two years without water due to pandemic restrictions, this year the font is buried



under heavy plastic with a thickening coat of dust.

It's a reality of construction that the font was drained and we are prevented from accessing it, which that may be significant in its own way.

One of the key elements guiding the re-imagining of our church was the priority of connecting the baptismal font with the altar, of establishing what the guidelines on Church design and construction identify as the "integral relationship between the baptismal font and the altar." Until the altar is in place and we are able to gather around it, so too the font is inaccessible. One will be consecrated and the other renewed – together.

The architectural drawings of the re-imagined church understandably emphasize the primary sanctuary, where the altar, ambo, tabernacle and other furnishings will be located. What those renderings did not depict was how the font, essentially, inspires that plan. It's pre-

sumed that we are looking into the renovated church from the font, although several people viewed the plan and wondered what would happen to the font.

While not evident in the plans, that essential link of font and altar, of Baptism and Eucharist will be impossible to miss. As you enter the church and approach the font, it will be crystal clear as to how to proceed, where to go next, just as in our sacramental life we proceed from the waters of new life to the food and drink of the Lord's table.

And, then, nourished and renewed, we pass the font again, maybe marking ourselves again, sealing and signing ourselves with the cross, before returning to the ongoing mission we share as people baptized and fed, the mission of discipleship.

Water may not be as abundant in our worship this Easter, but that doesn't detract from our baptismal mission. **TL**
