IT'S BEEN MENTIONED often in recent days that Queen Elizabeth's 70-year reign included her collaboration with 15 prime ministers of Great Britain, including, remarkably, Winston Churchill, as well as meeting 13 U.S. presidents. (Curiously, she never met President Lyndon Johnson, although her sister, Princess Margaret, visited the White House in 1965, and



the Queen met Lady Bird, the president's wife, in 1991 in Texas.)

Little mention, however, has been made of Queen Elizabeth's encounters with many, but not all, of the seven popes whose service coincided with her reign. There's historical significance in such meetings in that some British royalty had frosty, if not deadly, relationships with the Roman Catholic Church – King Henry VIII comes to mind.

Elizabeth was not a royal pioneer in matters of papal meetings. Her great-grandfather, King Edward VII, visited Pope Leo XIII in 1903, a few years after his landmark encyclical *Rerum Novarum*, on the dignity of work, which is regarded as the foundational text of Catholic social teaching. King George V and Queen Mary, Elizabeth's grandparents, met Pope Pius XI in 1923.

Elizabeth's first brush with the papacy came in 1950 when, as Princess Elizabeth See **QUEEN & POPES** on Page 7

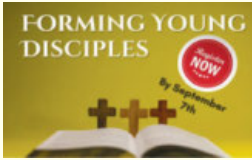
THE SUNDAY READINGS THIS WEEK

beth, she met Pope Pius XII during a Vatican visit; this was two years before she ascended to the throne. A decade later, in the first formal state visit between a pope and a British monarch, Pope John XXIII welcomed Queen Elizabeth to Rome in 1961.

Curiously, despite Pope Paul VI's determination to engage with the world and his unprecedented papal travel to other continents, such as North America, he never met the Queen during his papacy that extended from 1963-78. Nor is there much historical record as to why.

There is a practical reason as to why Queen Elizabeth never met Pope John Paul I, who, incidentally, was beatified just days before her death. He was pope for only 33 days in 1978.

The dearth of papal-royal visits would change dramatically during the pontificate of John Paul II. Indeed, Queen Elizabeth was one of dozens of world leaders John Paul would meet, often addressing intense matters of war and peace, albeit privately. The queen met with John Paul in 1980 at the Vatican, and then, finally, a pope visited Buckingham Palace in 1982. The queen visited John Paul II in Rome one last time in 2000.

Pope Benedict XVI visited the Queen in Scotland in 2010 and she met with Pope Francis in Rome in 2014, which would be the last of her papal encounters.

In responding the death of Queen Elizabeth on Sept. 8 at the age of 98, Pope Francis said: "I willingly join all who mourn her loss in praying for the late Queen's eternal rest, and in paying tribute to her life of unstinting service to the good of the nation and the commonwealth, her example of devotion to duty, her steadfast witness of faith in Jesus Christ and her firm hope in his promises." **TL**




