**ONE OF THE THINGS** that can easily go unnoticed in the reports of the early Church is the importance of the community. The significance of other believers in encouraging, comforting, empowering, enlightening, challenging, correcting, guiding and loving one another. Most idealistically, holding all things in common and sharing according to need. Or, maybe more realistically, being present as



best they could, to collaborate in determining how best to maneuver this "new way" of being.

In our contemporary Church we can often take the community for granted. So many of us strive for independence, pursuing what's best for me; we can lose sight of how essential the community of believers is. We see this even in our worship. Consider how we congregate – often with considerable distance from the next person. For some of us, social distancing was something we'd practiced well before the pandemic.

Indeed, that forceful dynamic of a community gathered for worship has yet to really be restored following the restrictions of Covid. Many of us have returned to Mass, but many others haven't. How we gather is different because of how many are present and, to be honest, because of how many aren't.



**Profession of Faith** (The Apostles' Creed)

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.



**KNEELING & STANDING:** People at pews without kneelers, if able, are asked to remain standing for the Eucharistic Prayer and throughout the communion procession. At communion time, we remain standing, as a sign of unity, until everyone has received communion.

**CONSECRATED LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS** are available from Fr. Tom as communion is distributed. Communicants will be invited to take a pyx, a container containing the host, and to return the pyx after Mass.

**BOWING:** The Church asks that worshipers bow slightly toward the Body of Christ and Blood of Christ as we are receiving communion and proclaiming "Amen."

ent to me in our recent celebrations of Easter Sunday and First Communion. Among those joining us to celebrate the Resurrection were likely several who don't worship regularly, or maybe hadn't been to Mass since March 2020. Being immersed in a welcoming and energetic experience of worship might have instilled an encouragement in at least a few to join us again, maybe even every Lord's Day. We can hope.

In welcoming children to the Lord's table there were, again, at least a few more people gathered for Mass, largely I suppose family members and friends, but hopefully a few parishioners. A larger assembly helped convey to the children, as well as to visitors, our regard for the significance of this celebration.

That's a large part of why we celebrate First Communion at our regular Lord's Day Masses, as opposed to separate "special" liturgies. The children are deepening their initiation into the Church; we - the Church - have a role in encouraging them by being present with them, celebrating with them. The same is true

of Baptism. It is an initiation into the Church, which is best conveyed when we celebrate Baptism at Mass – with family and friends to be sure, but also with a community of believers who take on a responsibility of helping to form and encourage new disciples.

This is nothing new. As I mentioned, our ancestors knew it millennia ago. TL


