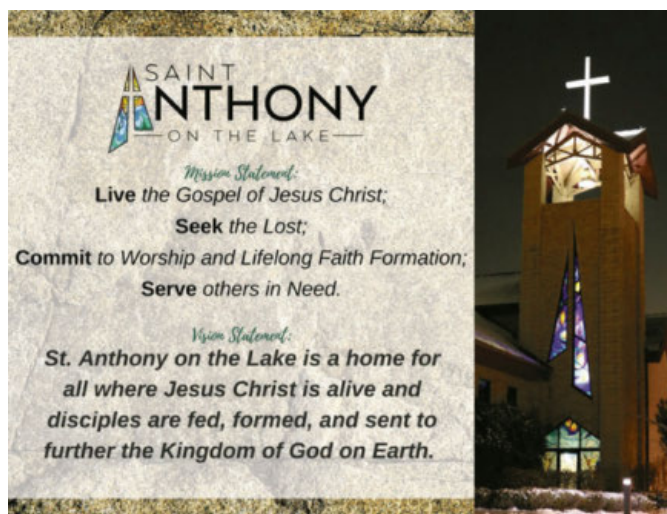

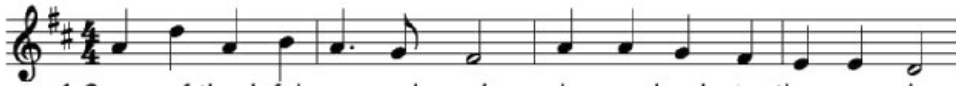

# PARISH LETTER ON TAX DONATIONS

It's that time of the year when we will be preparing tax letters for all our donors. This year, like last year, we will be e-mailing your tax donation letter to those that have a valid e-mail address on file. By e-mailing out the tax letters we save well over \$1,000 in printing and postage cost alone. This does not include the staff time involved in printing, stuffing and mailing the documents.



The tax letters will be in the same format as last year. Any donation of \$250.00 or more will be listed separately. The letter will come via e-mail and can be printed on any printer. The e-mail will be sent to the address we have on file in the parish database as "primary" for your family. If you need to update your e-mail address, please call the parish office at 262.691.1173 or e-mail us at **parish@stanthony.cc**. Those who do not have an e-mail address on file will have the tax letter mailed to them.

The tax letters will go out about the third week in January. If you received an e-mail from the parish about our "Hearts on Fire" Signature Event, then we have your correct e-mail address on file. If you did not receive the e-mail postcard on December 3rd, you should call the parish office to update your information.

In this New Year, may you change your direction and not dates, change your commitments and not the calendar, your attitude and not the actions, and bring about a change in your faith, your force and your focus and not the fruit. May you live up to the promises you have made and may you create for you and your loved ones the happiest New Year ever. Welcome 2022 (Thank God)!

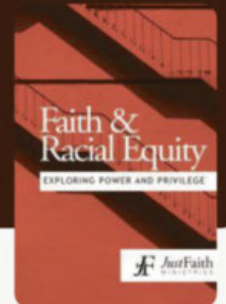

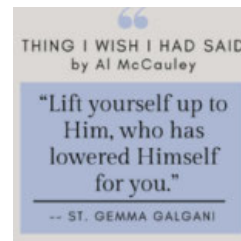
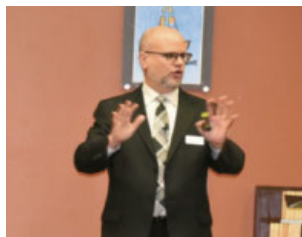
### Catholic Café

# OUR SCHOOL

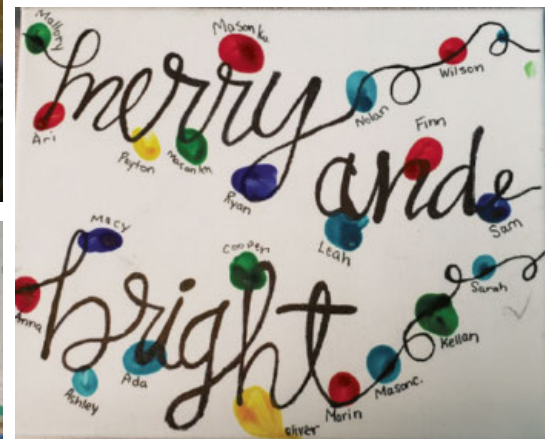
## Ms. Mary Heebsh 3rd Grade Teacher

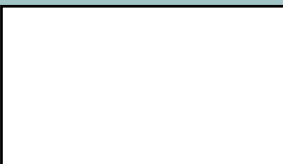
