



St. Anthony on the Lake Resource Team

St. Anthony on the Lake School is committed to helping all students learn and grow based on their unique and individual academic needs. In addition to the caring teachers and aides within the classroom, our Resource Team helps hone in on students' specific needs. Jennifer Guthrie provides individual and small group instruction to promote letter/sound recognition and writing to K4-K5 students; phonics, decoding, and fluency skills to enhance our K5-3rd grade students' reading abilities; and comprehension skill and strategy instruction to 4th-8th grade students to help them better understand and respond to what they read. Brenda Schleifer supports the 1st and 2nd grade classrooms by providing additional small group, large group, and/or individual instruction across all subject areas. Brenda also co-teaches middle school Writing Lab. Diane Tylinski, our middle school math teacher, also provides mathematic support and enrichment opportunities to upper elementary students.

In addition to academic skill support, our Resource Team works to support our students with special needs. Once a student is diagnosed with a special need (ADHD, Dyslexia, Executive Function Disorder, etc.), our team can create an Educational Action Plan (EAP) that specifies the accommodations and modifications necessary to promote academic success. If you are ever in a position where you're concerned that "something else" may be going on with your child, our Resource Team is here to assist and support you. You can reach out to us directly or inform your classroom teacher. We understand the sensitivity related to such and will uphold your wishes every step of the way.




