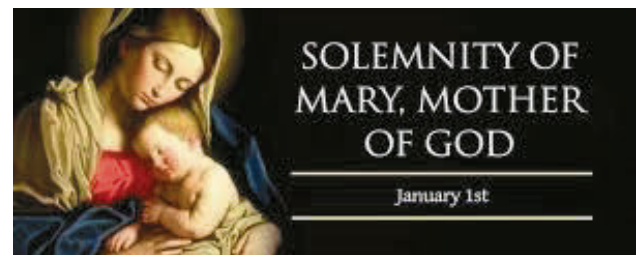

Greenleaf Church Cleaners Needed

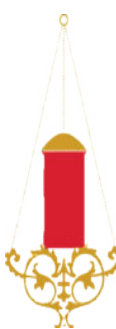

Today, December 26th, 2021, is the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

This feast day honors Jesus, the Blessed Mother, and

Saint Joseph as the holiest of families, and therefore a model for all Christians families. They were holy because they placed God at the center of their family life, they loved and sacrificed for one another, and they radiated that love to others.

The Feast teaches us about Jesus, Mary, and Joseph and about each one of us and our own families is called to share and love as the Holy Family modeled for us.

The 12 Days of Christmas

"The Twelve Days of Christmas" song was used to secretly pass on the ideology of Christianity. Each gift is said to symbolizes a different aspect of the faith.

The 2 Turtle Doves are the **two main parts of the Bible**.

The 3 French hens are the **three theological virtues**.

The 4 Calling Birds are the **four gospels or the four evangelists**.

The 7 Swans A-swimming are the **seven gifts of the Holy Spirit and/or the seven sacraments**.

The 8 Maids A-milking are the **eight beatitudes**.

The 10 Lords A-leaping are the **Ten Commandments**.

The 11 Pipers Piping are the **eleven faithful apostles**.

The 12 Drummers Drumming are the **twelve points of doctrine in the Apostle's Creed**.
