


Greenleaf Church Cleaners Needed

Today, December 26th, 2021, is the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

This feast day honors Jesus, the Blessed Mother, and

Saint Joseph as the holiest of families, and therefore a model for all Christians families. They were holy because they placed God at the center of their family life, they loved and sacrificed for one another, and they radiated that love to others.

The Feast teaches us about Jesus, Mary, and Joseph and about each one of us and our own families is called to share and love as the Holy Family modeled for us.

The 7 Swans A-swimming are the **seven gifts of the** Holy Spirit and/or the seven sacraments.

The 8 Maids A-milking are the eight beatitudes.

The 9 Ladies Dancing are the **nine fruits of the Holy Spirit.**

The 10 Lords A-leaping are the Ten Commandments.

The 11 Pipers Piping are the eleven faithful apostles.

The 12 Drummers Drumming are the **twelve points of doctrine in the Apostle's Creed.**
