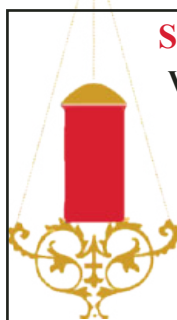
Monthly Prayer Intentions:

St. Angela Merici

On March 21, 1474, Angela was born in Desenzano, Italy. At age 10, she and her sister were orphaned, and lived a quiet Catholic life with an uncle. Her sister died young.

Inspired by the Holy Spirit, Angela dedicated herself to the Lord. She prayed for God to reveal the condition of her sister, and she was blessed with a vision of her sister in heaven with the company of saints. Angela then joined the Third Order of St. Francis, and consecrated herself to God.

When Angela was 20, her uncle passed away, so she returned to Desenzano. Her heart was moved when she found that the young girls in her hometown were uneducated and had no hope. Angela opened her home to these girls, and began teaching them, including the Catholic faith.

It was revealed to Angela in another vision that she should found an institution with other consecrated women to devote their lives toward the training of young girls.

Angela liked to remind those she worked with, "Reflect that in reality you have a greater need to serve the poor than they have of your service." Thanks to her charm and natural leadership qualities, her endeavors succeeded. A neighboring town, Brescia, invited her to establish a similar school.

In 1524, she had an opportunity to visit the Holy Land. During her travels, she was struck with blindness on the island of Crete. She continued her journey with enthusiasm and visited sacred shrines anyway. Upon returning home, her sight was miraculously restored at the same place where the blindness struck. Angela learned through this experience that she must never shut her eyes to the needs around her.

Angela's goal was to elevate family life through Christian education for women, including future wives and mothers. One of her favorite sayings: "Disorder in society is the result of disorder in the family." Her group—the Ursulines—was the first women's religious order to work outside of a cloister, and the first teaching order in the Catholic Church. They opened several schools and orphanages.

She is the patron saint of sickness, disabled and physically challenged people, and those grieving the loss of parents. Angela's feast day is January 27, the day she died in 1540.

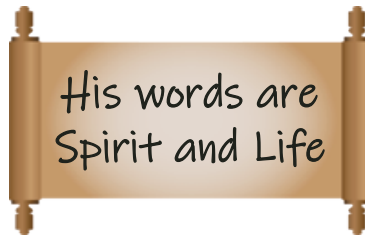
