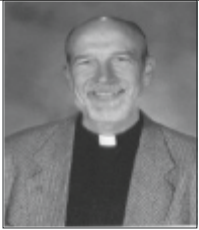

From the Pastor Desk.....

What would Jesus say today in America??

The following reflections are from a good friend of mine, a fellow Board member in the ecumenical “unity initiative” I belong to. His name is **Alexie Laushkin**, and he is a member of a non-denominational Christian congregation in the Washington DC area. Alexie is a brilliant young man, with amazing insight into our human and Christian condition, and also our struggles to find unity. He recently posted this message on his Facebook page, and I thought it a VERY insightful contribution into the highly divisive and demeaning dialogues going on at present in our politics, as seen most recently in the confirmation hearings on Brett Kavanaugh.

I’m convinced if Jesus came to America he’d likely say very little to the Christians of this country. American Christians would line up and hold rallies about how he doesn’t take social justice seriously because he rejects socialism, how he wants Christians to stop supporting weak politicians and instead go for the fighters, how he doesn’t judge you for relationships because love is love, and on and on and on.

What could Jesus say to a church gone mad. He’d probably spend time with those open to his message and challenge all of us who have just stopped wanting to see the bigger picture of a God who wants to see all people reconciled to himself, who cares little for wealth and power, isn’t impressed with temporal success, and instead seeks to engage those in pain and with a humble disposition with love.

Our questions aren’t the questions of Christ, which should give us pause. When you can’t wait for 2020, you might just wonder if Jesus would be waiting with you. The big command is seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness.

It’s an ask: can the kingdom of heaven (the things of God) compete for your affections on earth, because that kingdom changes how you see other people and how you see your enemies and those things, people, and circumstances who make this life wearisome and difficult. It’s not a kingdom of success but of the lasting change of our inner character.

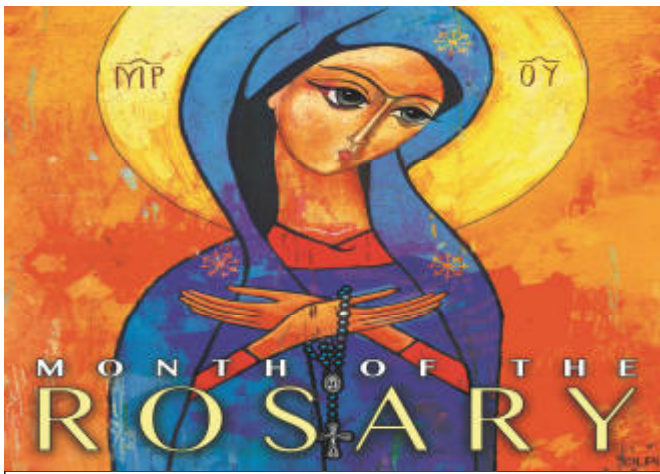
