

### BLESSING OF THE HOME ON THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY

From the altar the blessing of the church extends itself on Epiphany to the homes of the Faithful. This custom of blessing the home takes place in many parishes around the Feast of the Epiphany. The priest blesses the house if he can be present, but if not, a member of the family may do so in the following fashion:

A family member asks God to bless his or her home by signing the initials of the Three Wise Men over the main entrance in a prayer like this:

"Let us pray: Lord bless our home and keep all who live here safe through your holy friends, CASPER, MELCHOIR and BALTHASAR. We ask this through Jesus Christ, your Son. Amen.

Sign with blessed chalk: 20+C+M+B+18

Blessed chalk is available in the entrance.
