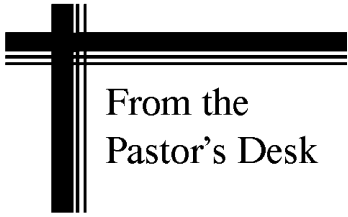

Dear Cathedral and St. Mary Mission Family,

Welcome to all as we gather to celebrate our Savior's birth at Christmas! Because of the way Christmas falls on Saturday, Dec. 25<sup>th</sup> we have our Masses at Christmas Eve Vigil at 5:00 p.m. and Midnight Mass, then Christmas Day Masses at 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., and 12:00 p.m. here at the Cathedral. St. Mary Mission has Christmas Day Mass at 10:30 a.m. There will not be a 4:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday evening, as it would not be for the following Sunday of Holy Family.

Masses for the Feast of the Holy Family will all be on Sunday, Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at the Cathedral and St. Mary's Sunday Mass at 10:30 a.m. as usual.

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God comes next Saturday, Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> with a Vigil Mass on Friday, Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:30 p.m. and Masses on Saturday, Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. St. Mary's will have a Mass at 1:00 p.m. on Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>. The obligation is actually lifted for this Solemnity, but it is a wonderful way to start the New Year, and Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> is a First Saturday with its regular devotion

Again, I thank all whose work and ministry helps us lift our hearts to the Lord in worship, whether through sacred music, beautiful decorations, all the liturgical ministries and service of any kind for our Cathedral and for St. Mary Mission!

We start a great new study "The Case for Jesus" on Wed., Jan. 5<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. in the Media Room. It will feature video presentations by Brant Pitre, with discussion afterward. 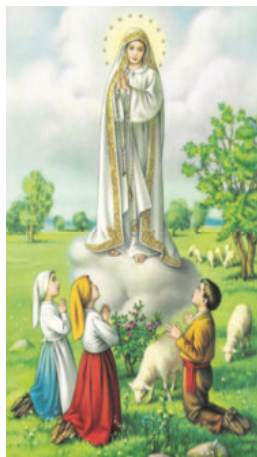


**FIRST WEDNESDAY - DEVOTION TO ST. JOSEPH**

**January 1st** is the first Saturday of the month. Mass is at 10:00am followed by First Saturday Devotions, per Our Lady's request. Confession is at 11am.



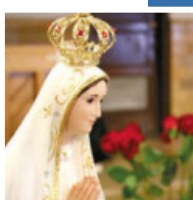

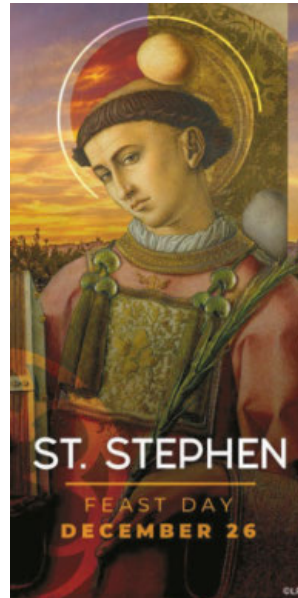

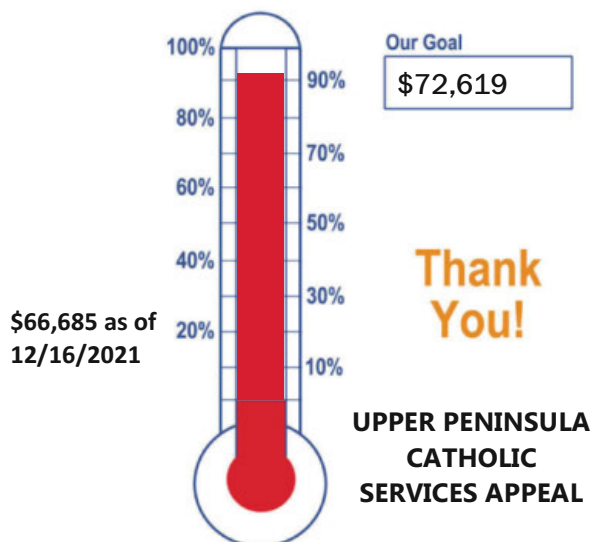
### ST. CHRISTOPHER PASTY SALE—January 12
