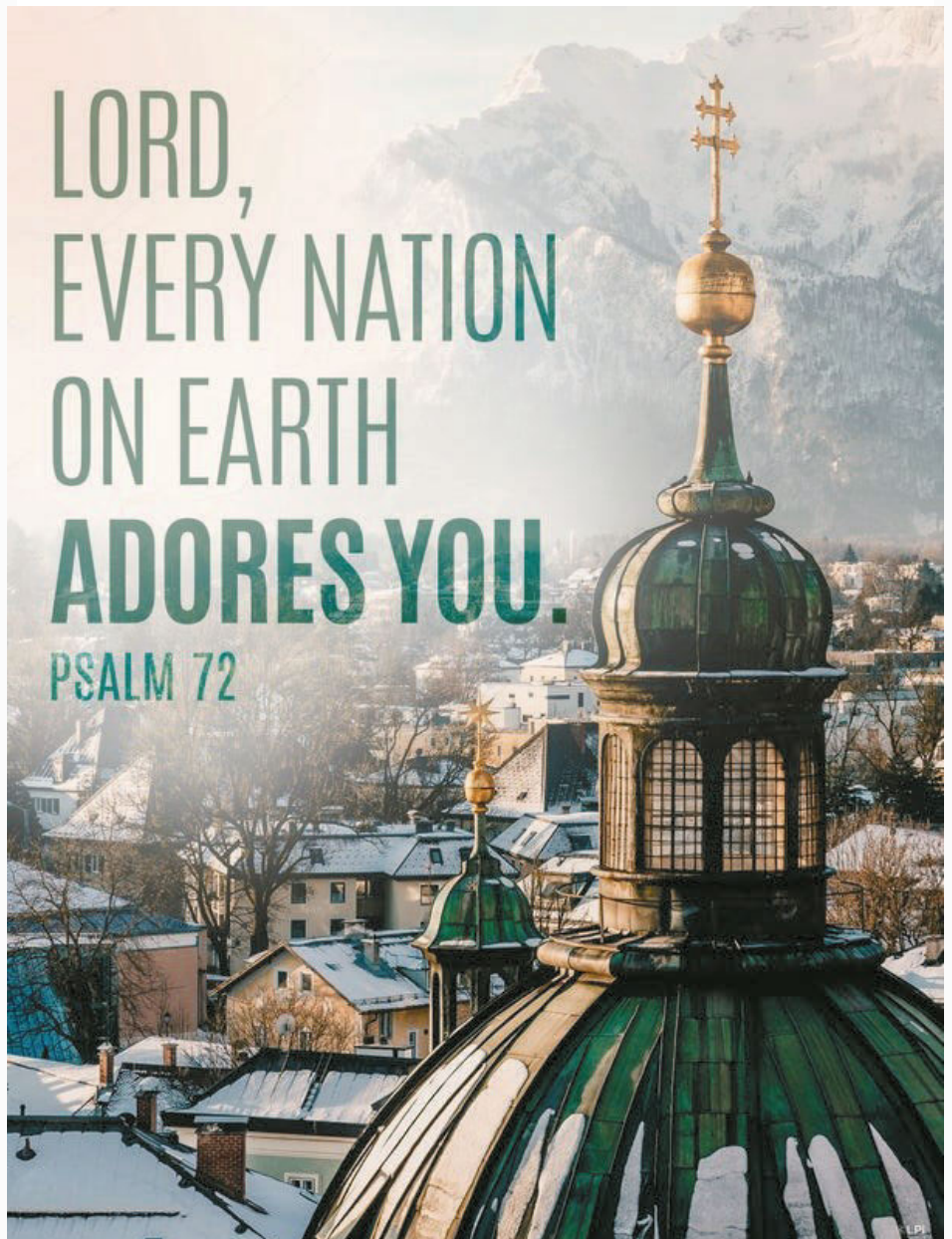

Dear Cathedral and St. Mary Mission Families,

A happy and blessed New Year to all of you! This weekend we enter into this year of 2022 with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on Saturday, Jan. 1st. 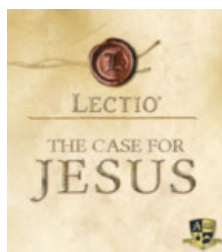

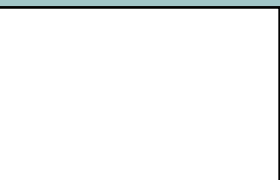
