And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.” That first community on Pentecost day, already having experienced the Ascension of Jesus into heaven and having received the promise of the Holy Spirit from Him, would have immediately recognized that the promise was being fulfilled. The Spirit was poured out on them. Just as Jesus poured out on the Apostles the Spirit to forgive sins in our gospel reading, so now the Spirit was poured out on them to proclaim the Good News to the world, all tongues, all languages.

We all have been baptized—Father, Son and Holy Spirit—and most of us have been confirmed. The Spirit is here, within us individually and within our community, different gifts as the Spirit desires to bless us. It is truly the combination of all our good gifts that make us Church. It is our use of those gifts to “speak” our lives for Christ that makes the Spirit present in our thoughts, words and actions. The Holy Spirit is as present today as He was that first Pentecost. Maybe not with all the whiz and bang of that first one, but present with each of us as we consciously and freely open our minds and hearts to receive Him. Always here, always present, always desiring to guide us to “proclaim” the Spirit’s presence by the way we live our lives.

Come, Holy Spirit, come, fill us with your presence in every moment. You are the Love of God for us, in us and with us! Sharing our gifts with one another, You make of us one Body, one Blood poured out on the earth. Does my life reflect the fruits of the Holy Spirit...does my life show forth joy, love, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control? Those are indications that we are in the Spirit of Jesus! The Spirit is here. Are we? Come, Spirit, come. St Joseph, pray for us! Fr. Jim

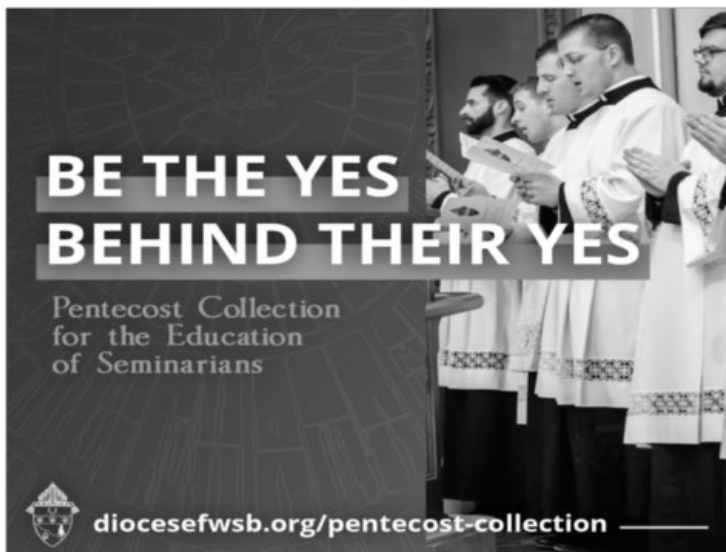

What is the Difference between the Ascension and the Assumption?

Ascension of Jesus, The Catholic Encyclopedia gives a succinct definition of this first event. The elevation of Christ into heaven by His own power in presence of His disciples the fortieth day after His Resurrection. The key phrase in this definition is “by His own power.” Jesus is God, and that means when he returned to Heaven, he did so through his own abilities and not by any outside force. He was the cause of his ascension, proving again that he is God.

Assumption of the Virgin Mary, On the other hand, is quite different. She was taken up to Heaven by God’s power and not her own. She was not the being that raised herself to Heaven. God Himself raised her to be with Him.
