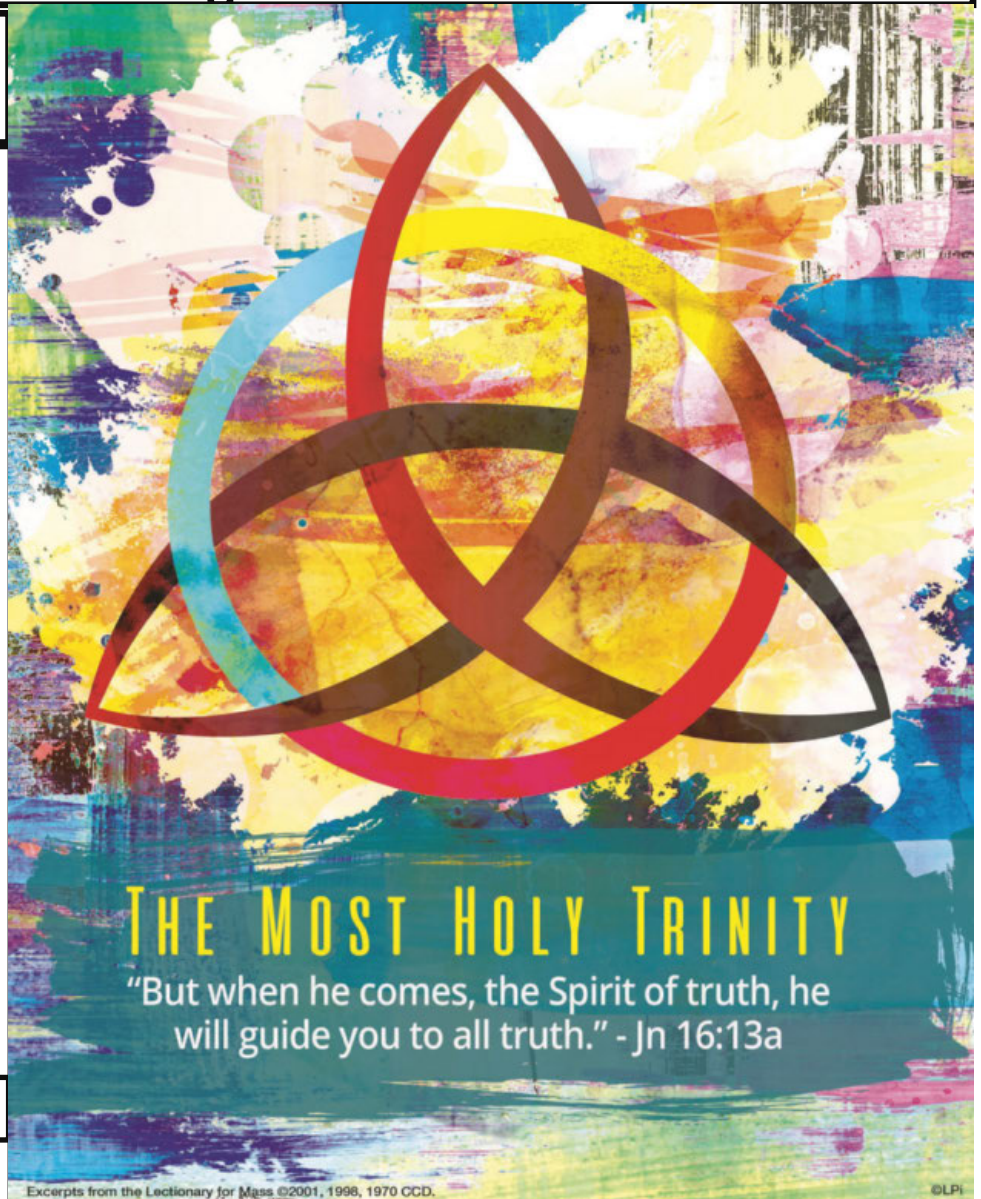

This mystery beyond all mysteries, difficult for us to wrap our minds around it, instead wraps Itself around us. We are loved.

A parish update for you: our St Joseph School principal, Jenn Enrietto, has resigned to take a principal position at a school in Indianapolis. Please keep Jenn and family in your prayers as they mourn the loss of a son and brother. Following diocesan procedures, I named a search committee to recommend her successor for hiring. Mike Ellert, school board president, Beth Novy, a teacher here for 23 years, Andrea Ferguson, a teacher here this past year, and Christina Gaar, who headed our committee as she did four years ago, comprised the committee. Candidates who made application through the diocese were eligible for interviewing with the committee. After interviewing Kathleen Mulligan, the assistant principal of St Vincent School in Fort Wayne for the past seven years, the committee has unanimously recommended her to be our next principal and I fully concur. Kathleen, you will be a most welcome addition to our school community. Please keep her and our school in your prayer. She officially begins as principal on July 1st. St Joseph, pray for us. Fr. Jim
