O Body of Christ, O Blood of the Lord! After celebrating Trinity Sunday last week, this week the Church turns our attention to that other great mystery of our Catholic faith, the Holy Eucharist. What a gift! Jesus, on the night before He died for us, doing Passover with His disciples, knowing they would be shattered by His death the next day, took some of the matzoh unleavened bread, and said to them, "Take and eat, this is my Body." And then a cup of the Passover wine, "Take this and drink of it, this is my Blood." It must have stunned them...these slow to believe people...but He is not finished. "Do this in remembrance of Me." St Paul adds, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until He comes." Do you hear Jesus? He wanted to have a way to remain with them...and us. Remember me like this, and I will be with you until the end of time. My Body, My Blood. Eat and drink Me...I am here with you. True Body, true Blood, soul and divinity. Not just a nice symbol, but rather the reality it signifies. The Real Jesus...Body and Blood!

How can we not believe this? How can we not take His Word? The Church did not invent this. Jesus, the Son of God, did... and told us to do it...to remember Him is this way until the end of time...and HE WOULD BE PRESENT IN IT WITH US. We Catholics have been doing this for 2000 years. And He will continue to do this every time we gather in faith to celebrate our Mass. When we come to receive Holy Communion at this Mass, come with a renewed faith in Jesus. Let your Amen mean yes, I believe. The Real Presence...O Body of Christ, O Blood of the Lord!

**Thursday, June 23, We, the Church, Celebrates
The Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist**

John the Baptist was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, kinswoman of Mary, the mother of Jesus, who was known for evangelization and his baptizing of Christ in the Jordan. John began public ministry around 30 AD, and was known for attracting large crowds across the province of Judaea and around the Jordan River. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you." John instructed his followers to turn to Christ, calling Him the "Lamb of God" and these people were among the first Christians. Following his baptism of Christ, John's popularity grew so much that he alarmed King Herod. Herod ordered him arrested and imprisoned. John was beheaded by Herod. John the Baptist died sometime between 33 and 36 AD.

The Church year has two cycles. The more important cycle is the Temporal Cycle. The life of Christ is relived in liturgical time, in both real time and Church's memory. Throughout the year the Paschal Mystery (Christ's work of redemption through His birth, life, passion, death, and resurrection and ascension) is relived, and broken down into the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week, Easter and Ordinary Time. Sundays are the usual means by which this cycle unfolds.

At the same time with the Temporal Cycle, the Sanctoral Cycle progresses. The Church honors Mary, Mother of God "with a special love. She is inseparably linked with the saving work of her son" (CCC 1172). Then the memorials of martyrs and other saints are kept by the Church. They are held up to us as examples "who draw all men to the Father through Christ, and through their merits she begs for God's favors" (CCC 1173).

This is one of the few saint feast days that is connected with the temporal calendar, not the sanctoral calendar, because John the Baptist was intimately involved in Christ's work of redemption. Charting or making your own liturgical calendar would be a great family project.

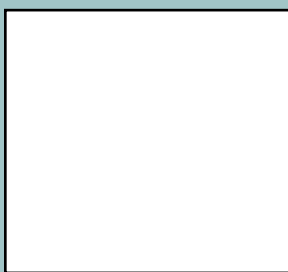
