

Our journey with Jesus up to Jerusalem on this 16th Sunday in Ordinary time confronts us with a From the pair of readings in which human beings host a meal for God: Abraham for the Lord and Martha and Mary for Jesus. But is it really possible for us to "do God a favor" by giving Him a nice meal?

Let's further explore both readings. In the Christian tradition, the Genesis reading of Abraham and the Lord has always suggested a mystical appearance of the Holy Trinity. The text says, "The Lord appeared to Abraham," but three men show up. In this meal, Abraham is eager to serve the Lord and feed Him/Them well. But this meal is not about what Abraham can do for the Lord. Do we really think these three angelic visitors needed material food? Instead, this meal is about what the Lord can do for Abraham: provide him a son and heir, Issac, in fulfillment of His covenant promise.

On His way to Jerusalem, Jesus stops in the home of Martha and Mary to share a meal with them. Like Abraham, Martha and Mary have the opportunity to host God in a meal in their home. Martha and Mary have different attitudes about Jesus being in their home. Mary is concerned about what Jesus can give to her, Martha is concerned about what she can do for Jesus, serving Him food. Jesus gently lets Martha know He understands her good intention. "You are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." The one thing that Mary is doing is communion with God...the only thing that will matter at the end of life, communion in heaven with God.

We are here today to enjoy a covenant meal with God present. The Mass is not something we do for God, nor is it a meal we host for God. The Mass is something God does for us...He is the Host of the meal. We do not do God a favor by showing up for Mass on Sunday. God does us a favor by hosting a meal for us every Sunday in which He offers Himself to us as food, in the most intimate act of communion with Himself. Mass is not about what we do for God, but about what God does for us. Yes, we are here to give Him thanks and praise. But He is here for Communion with us, to work in our hearts, to forgive our sin, to transform the way we think and act. He is here so we can become what we eat and drink...to be Him in our own bodies, to be Him in our world. St Joseph, pray for us. Fr. Jim

EUCHARISTIC SAINT FOR JUNE - THOMAS AQUINAS
St. Kateri is the first member of a North American tribe to be declared a saint. She was born in 1656 in a village along the Mohawk River in New York. Her father was a Mohawk chief, and her mother was a Christian Algonquin raised among the French. When St. Kateri embraced the Catholic faith and rejected her tribe's customs by refusing to marry or take part in pagan ceremonies, she was shunned and punished by her tribe, but she remained steadfast to her faith for the love of God. Kateri astounded the Jesuits with her deep spirituality and her devotion to the Eucharist. She took every opportunity to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Because of her inspiring devotion, many strove to be near her when she received communion. Her feast day is July 14.
