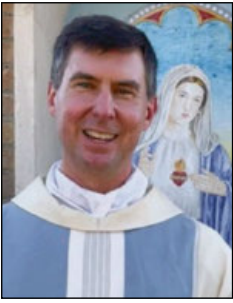

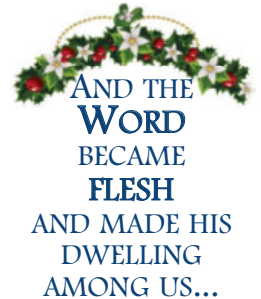

*Should you come forward in the procession to receive a blessing, please **cross your arms over your chest** as an indication that you wish to receive a blessing, rather than receive Holy Communion. Let us pray for each other!*

CHRISTMAS AND SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Catholics are obligated to attend Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation (including Christmas). This year, even though the Christmas obligation and Sunday obligation fall back-to-back, each has their own, distinct obligation. To fulfill the Christmas obligation, Catholics may attend Mass anytime after 4:00 pm on Friday, December 24, or any time on Saturday, December 25. To fulfill the Sunday obligation, Catholics must attend a second Mass anytime after 4:00 pm on Saturday, December 25 (St. Vincent's will NOT offer an evening Mass on December 25) or any time on Sunday, December 26. This year, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on January 1 also falls on a Saturday, thus, there is no obligation this year.

Incense may be used at the 8:15 am Masses December 27 through December 31 as we celebrate the **Octave of Christmas.**

Incense may be used at the 9:00 am Mass on Saturday, January 1, as we celebrate The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (*which is NOT a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on Saturday*).

Incense may be used at the 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 5:00 pm Mass on Sunday, January 2, as we celebrate The Epiphany of the Lord. No incense will be used at the 5:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, January 1, or at the 7:00 am Mass and 1:30 pm Sensory-Friendly Mass on Sunday, January 2.

SOLEMNITY OF MARY, MOTHER OF GOD

January 1, Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is not a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on Saturday. We will offer Adoration and a 5:30 pm Vigil Mass on Friday, December 31, as well as a 9:00 am Mass on Saturday. The 5:00 pm Mass celebrated on Saturday evening is a vigil Mass for Sunday, December 2 (Epiphany of the Lord).

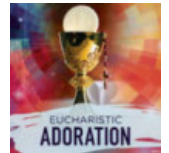

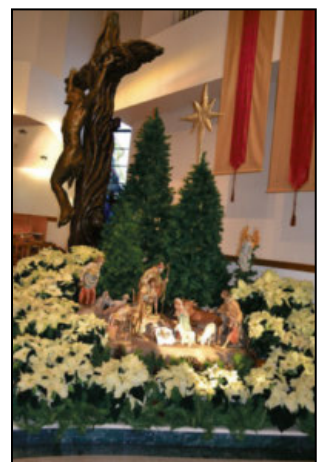

12 Days of Christmas

2nd Day

This year, the Church celebrates the **Feast of The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph** on

Sunday, December 26 (replacing the Feast of St. Stephen, First Martyr, which is usually celebrated on December 26). On this feast day we ask God's blessing on all families, big or small, and ask that they may obtain the guidance of the Holy Family.



The Church celebrates the **Feast of St. John, Apostle and Evangelist**, on Monday, December 27.

3rd Day

St. John traveled with Jesus everywhere and become so close to Jesus that he was known as the beloved disciple. He was the only one of the Twelve who did NOT forsake Jesus in the hour of His passion. Jesus made him guardian of the Blessed Mother before he died on the cross. John was the first to reach the tomb upon hearing of the Resurrection and was the first to recognize Jesus as the risen Lord at the lake of Tiberias. Let us strive to be as close to Jesus as John was.

4th Day

On December 28, we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Innocents**. This feast is a remembrance of the

massacre of young children in Bethlehem by King Herod the Great in his attempt to kill the infant Jesus (Matthew 2:16-18).

5th Day

No confessions today (December 29) as we continue to celebrate the Octave of The Nativity of the Lord!

The Gospel today (December 30) tells of the prophetess, Anna, who spoke about Jesus "to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem" as Joseph, Mary and Jesus visited the Temple to fulfill "all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord." After the Holy Family's visit to the temple, they returned to Galilee where Jesus "grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him."

6th Day

7th Day

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

Join us for the opportunity to pray before the exposed Blessed Sacrament in the church on **Friday, December 31**, from 4:30 - 5:15 pm. We then celebrate the 5:30 pm Vigil Mass for the **Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God** (not a holy day of obligation this year since it falls on Saturday) in the Church (there is no 5:30 pm Mass in the Oratory today).

The 8th Day of Christmas, **Saturday, January 1**, is also **The Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God** (not a

holy day of obligation this year because it falls on Saturday). Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 am (and will be live-streamed in place of the 8:15 am Mass).

No confessions today (January 1) as we continue to celebrate the Octave of The Nativity of the Lord!

The 5:00 pm Mass today is a Vigil Mass for the Feast of The Epiphany of the Lord on Sunday.

9th Day

This year, the Church celebrates the **Feast of The Epiphany of the Lord** on **Sunday, January 2** (replacing the Feast

of St. Basil the Great and St. Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops and Doctors of the Church). Epiphany means "manifestation," or public display. The feast is usually celebrated January 6. In the US, it is celebrated on the Sunday nearest to January 6 (this year, **Sunday, January 2**). It originates from a story unique to Matthew (2:1-12). Magi from the East come to offer homage to the newborn King, presenting him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Since Matthew was writing primarily to a Jewish community, his concern was to show that Jesus did not come just for Jews, but for Gentiles as well. From his very birth, Jesus not only manifests himself to Jews, but also to Gentiles, who are prominently included in the manifestation, symbolized by the Magi and their journey.

We celebrate the **Holy Name of Jesus**, on Monday, January 3 (it is celebrated on the first "free" day after January 1).

10th Day

The name of Jesus is a name by which we are saved and a name that evil fears; when invoked, it can cast out demons. We honor and celebrate the name of Jesus because the name of God deserves reverence. "(A)t the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Phil 2:10-11)

11th Day

Celebrate the first American-born saint! St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was born in New York City in the late

1700s and raised Episcopalian. She married William Seton. Together they had five children. He fell ill, and the family moved to Italy for his health. While there, Elizabeth discovered Catholicism. Her husband eventually passed away, but God had more plans for the Seton family. Elizabeth felt a further stirring in her heart. She opened a school for girls in 1808. Within a year, Elizabeth had founded the Sisters of Charity, the first community for religious women established in the United States. Their work established the **first Catholic school system in the country**. On her feast day this **January 4th**, pray for our teachers and students!

12th Day

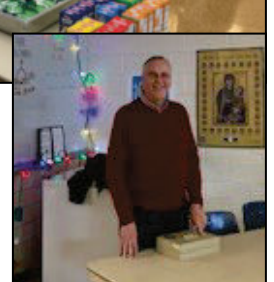

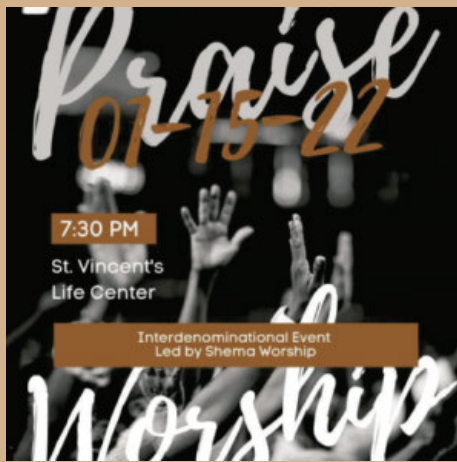
