

Incense may be used at the 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 5:00 pm Mass on Sunday, January 2, as we celebrate The Epiphany of the Lord. No incense will be used at the 5:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, January 1, or at the 7:00 am Mass and 1:30 pm Sensory-Friendly Mass on Sunday, January 2.

We use an incense which is hypoallergenic.

Until further notice, the section of pews near the confessionals will have every other pew roped off to provide social distancing during the 5 PM Saturday Vigil and 7 AM and 5 PM Masses on Sunday. 

What a fabulous year this was for The Giving Tree!




ALL the angels were taken, and gifts were returned early (which makes our jobs easier to deliver). SO MANY lives have been touched due to St. Vincent's love and generosity! Over 1,400 gifts were distributed throughout the Fort Wayne community. About 135 men at the **RESCUE MISSION** received a pair of sweatpants from St. Vincent parishioners. About 40 gifts were given to SCAN (Stop Child Abuse and Neglect) to take to clients on home visits. Many gifts were provided to CATHOLIC **CHARITIES** for their clients to "shop" for gifts for their family and to refugee families setting up a new household. Similarly, VINCENT VILLAGE received items for their low-income clients to establish a new household. The CHRIST CHILD SOCIETY, an organization that gives layettes to needy babies going home from the hospital received items to pass on. Additionally, the WOMEN'S CARE CENTER was given items for their Crib Club, to offer clients for participation in parenting classes. A MOTHER'S HOPE received gifts for their residents and workers and babies. Gifts were taken to CROSSROADS, a shelter for troubled youth, to brighten their Christmas. Over 100 foster children were adopted through STEP STONE FAMILY & YOUTH SERVICES and were given specially requested gifts. The residents of UNIVERSITY PARK NURSING HOME and KINGSTON CARE all received a loving gift while residents at BYRON HEALTH CENTER were given fun BINGO prizes. AVE MARIA HOUSE received gifts to brighten the days of their homeless visitors. Forty-eight veterans living at the SHEPHERD'S **HOUSE**, a transitional living home for men, received a set of bath towels and toiletries. Additionally, 35 men and 15 women living at **SERENITY HOUSE** and 15 residents of LIGHTHOUSE, received blankets with a devotion book. and backpacks. Ten families, trying to make it on their own, were adopted through JUST NEIGHBORS -INTERFAITH HOMELESS NETWORK. Seven families were adopted through WHITINGTON HOMES. Single, homeless women at ST. JOSEPH MISSIONS were provided a sweatshirt and scrub bottoms to begin their stay. GIGI'S **PLAYHOUSE** requested a few supplies to help their clients. 
