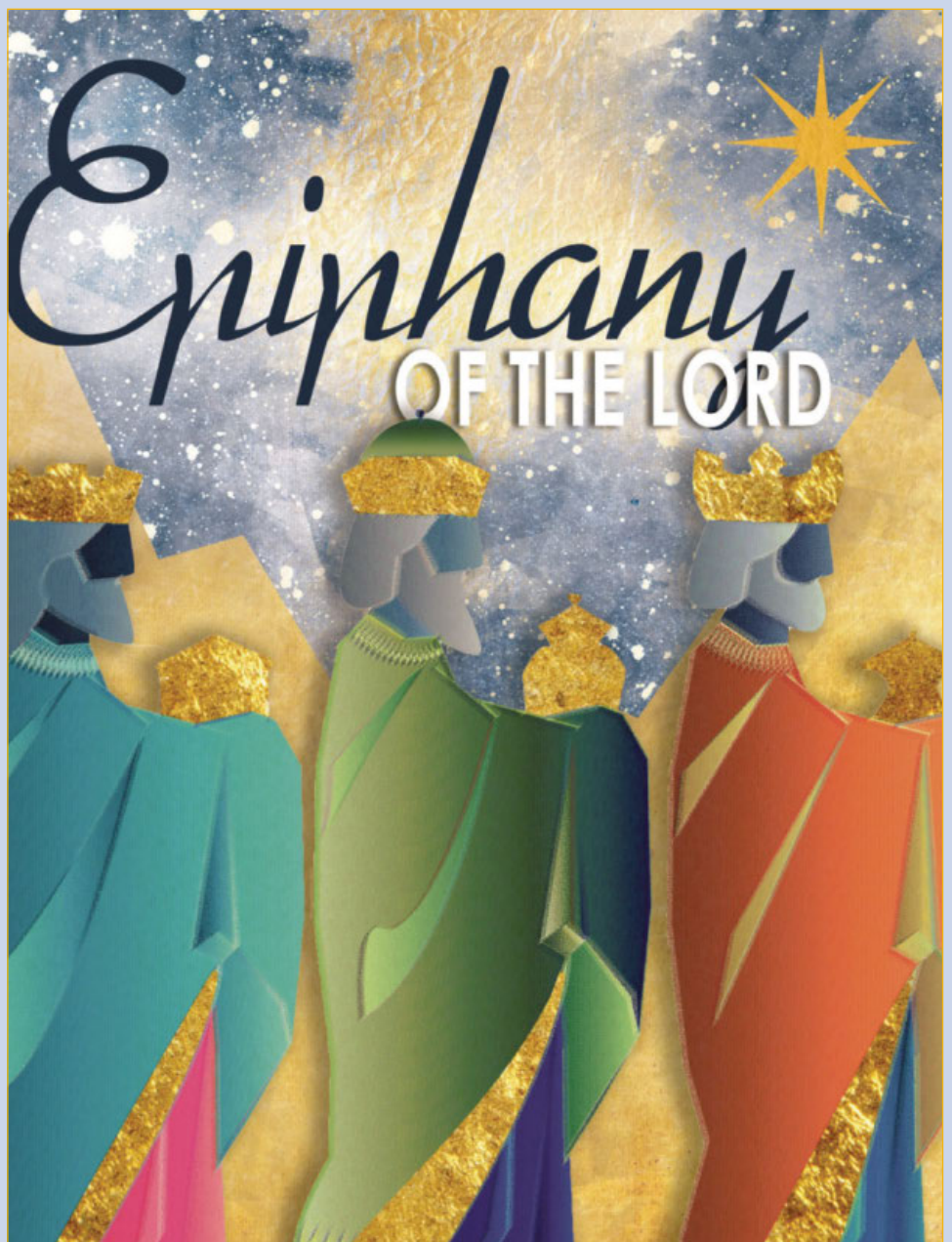

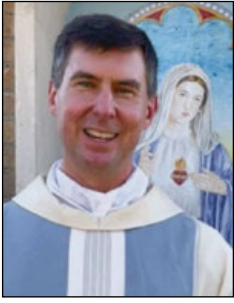

Happy Feast of the Epiphany, and Happy New Year! In commemorating the visit of the wise men from the East to adore the newborn Christ, we celebrate the revelation of God to the peripheries and His blessing in our flesh to future generations, including our own. Jesus is Lord and Savior of all—Jew and Gentile, rich and poor, those who are near and those who are far.

I am so grateful to all of the parish staff and volunteers who have invited and welcomed visitors to St. Vincent's in these Christmas days and have worked tirelessly through the extra challenges of this time. Please come to our Epiphany concert this **Wednesday, January 5**, at 7PM to rest and enjoy the music of Christmas!

This weekend the gifts we consider are not simply the gold, frankincense, and myrrh of the Magi but the spiritual friendship Heaven wishes to give us in receiving a new saint companion for the year. Such is the simplicity and power of invitation, circulating more surely than any virus and bringing with it eternal health, comfort and joy.

USE OF INCENSE

Incense may be used at the 9:00 am Mass on Saturday, January 1, as we celebrate The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (*which is NOT a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on Saturday*).

Incense may be used at the 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 5:00 pm Mass on Sunday, January 2, as we celebrate The Epiphany of the Lord. No incense will be used at the 5:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, January 1, or at the 7:00 am Mass and 1:30 pm Sensory-Friendly Mass on Sunday, January 2.

We use an incense which is hypoallergenic.

Until further notice, the section of pews near the confessionals will have every other pew roped off to provide social distancing during **the 5 PM Saturday Vigil and 7 AM and 5 PM Masses on Sunday**. Anyone sitting in this section **must** wear a mask **when the ropes are on the pews**. This section will be open during the 9 AM and 11 AM Masses.

If you have health concerns, you are encouraged to sit in this section. The rest of the Church will remain open, and you may choose to wear a mask or not.

We are implementing this change as a true sacrificial act of charity for our brothers and sisters who have health concerns. If you are not concerned about social distancing or choose to not wear a mask, please find another place in the Church to accommodate those who use this section.

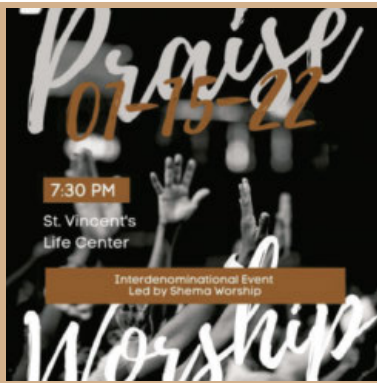

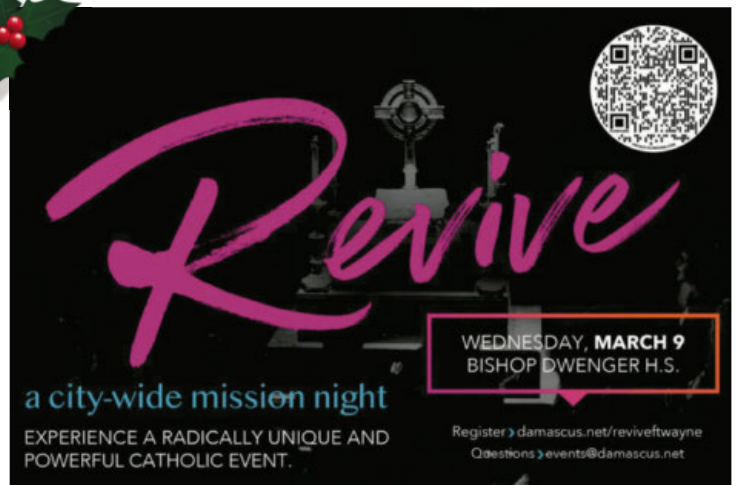

GIVING TREE THANK YOU!

What a fabulous year this was for The Giving Tree!



ALL the angels were taken, and gifts were returned early (which makes our jobs easier to deliver). **SO MANY** lives have been touched due to St. Vincent's love and generosity! Over 1,400 gifts were distributed throughout the Fort Wayne community. About 135 men at the **RESCUE MISSION** received a pair of sweatpants from St. Vincent parishioners. About 40 gifts were given to **SCAN** (Stop Child Abuse and Neglect) to take to clients on home visits. Many gifts were provided to **CATHOLIC CHARITIES** for their clients to "shop" for gifts for their family and to refugee families setting up a new household. Similarly, **VINCENT VILLAGE** received items for their low-income clients to establish a new household. The **CHRIST CHILD SOCIETY**, an organization that gives layettes to needy babies going home from the hospital received items to pass on. Additionally, the **WOMEN'S CARE CENTER** was given items for their Crib Club, to offer clients for participation in parenting classes. **A MOTHER'S HOPE** received gifts for their residents and workers and babies. Gifts were taken to **CROSSROADS**, a shelter for troubled youth, to brighten their Christmas. Over 100 foster children were adopted through **STEP STONE FAMILY & YOUTH SERVICES** and were given specially requested gifts. The residents of **UNIVERSITY PARK NURSING HOME** and **KINGSTON CARE** all received a loving gift while residents at **BYRON HEALTH CENTER** were given fun BINGO prizes. **AVE MARIA HOUSE** received gifts to brighten the days of their homeless visitors. 
