

# From Our Pastor



This weekend we find ourselves again in Ordinary Time, the Christmas season concluding with our celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Ordinary Time should not, however, be simply a "return to normal," as if the graces of this year's Christmas are fully unwrapped and already used, like last year's presents.

We have received new gifts from the Lord in these past days, even if they remain hidden or in seed form. These gifts are actually an unfolding of the gift of our Baptism (or, for those of us not yet Baptized, they are a preparation for it!), in which we receive from Christ our vocation of membership in the family of the Church and our call to be saints.

I am immeasurably grateful for your prayerful, supportive response to the news expressed in my letter regarding Fr. Eric Burgener. As I mentioned, I believe that it is vital for you to know in detail what the Diocesan structures of discernment are when there is a question of Priestly misconduct, and to meet personally some of the people who serve directly in this discernment.

I have invited both Mary Glowaski, Bishop Rhoades' assistant in pastoral care and victim assistance coordinator, and Fr. Matthew Coonan, Bishop's vicar for clergy, to lead a presentation at St. Vincent's on **Thursday, January 13**, from 6:30 - 8:00PM in the Kuzmich Life Center. It will cover our Diocese's outreach to and support of those who have suffered abuse, the process within the Church and beyond it for investigating and adjudicating these claims, and the rights and responsibilities of Priests, including their support and formation in our Diocese so that we are always growing in health and addressing pathologies.

If you have any questions you wish to submit ahead of time to be addressed, you can submit them via email (church@saintv.org with the subject line: "Outreach Presentation"), or place your questions in the labeled box outside of our Parish Office. Even though the presenters are not able to comment on certain specific details of particular cases, they will be able to provide an explanation of relevant principles designed to operate in these cases. Please submit your questions **by this Tuesday at noon**, so that our speakers will have sufficient time to consider as many of these inquiries as possible into their presentation.

Thank you for your continued prayers that—as the hymn goes—"We'll triumph through our sorrows and rise to bless Him still!"

Click the hour you'd like to adore, select the frequency and then "sign up" (you may also request substitutes for times you can't make it to adoration at saintv.weadorehim.com).

Diocesan directives instruct that we should stay home (with Mass obligation lifted) if feeling unwell: "Anyone (whether vaccinated or not) with a cough or fever, or who may otherwise be feeling sick, should still remain home."

The 9 AM Sunday Mass will continue to be streamed on the parish website, on YouTube and on Facebook for those who cannot attend in person.

Until further notice, the section of pews near the confessionals will have every other pew roped off to provide social distancing during the 5 PM Saturday Vigil and 7 AM and 5 PM Masses on Sunday. Anyone sitting in this section must wear a mask when the ropes are on the pews. This section will be open during the 9 AM and 11 AM Masses.

If you have health concerns, you are encouraged to sit in this section. The rest of the Church will remain open, and you may choose to wear a mask or not.

We are implementing this change as a true sacrificial act of charity for our brothers and sisters who have health concerns. If you are not concerned about social distancing or choose to not wear a mask, please find another place in the Church to accommodate those who use this section.




