

From Our Pastor



On this second Sunday of Lent, we are invited to follow Christ from the wilderness of the desert up to the heights of Mt. Tabor, to witness His glorious Transfiguration. Together with the Apostles Peter, James, and John, the Lord Jesus initiates us into an on-going dialogue with Moses and Elijah, who represent the Law and the Prophets—the ancient promises of God to Israel.

We continue to pray for all of those who are preparing for the Easter Sacraments, especially members of our RCIA who are on their way to Baptism at the Easter Vigil and to reception into full communion in the Catholic Church. Historically the season of Lent developed as a way for the whole Church to accompany this blessed group of people and welcome their final entry into the sacred dialogue spanning earth and Heaven, their ultimate belonging to the saving company of Jesus Christ and the saints, His friends. Please take the name of one of our Catechumens or Candidates from the basket in the gathering space, to spiritually adopt them in prayer throughout Lent.

As I have mentioned, part of our prayer and

almsgiving this Lent must be identifying those people from our family and friends whom we must personally invite back to church in the weeks and months aheadthis is one of the best works of almsgiving imaginable: to offer to people a relationship with Jesus Christ in the greatest family reunion ever—the Church together in prayer!

No one is meant to live in exile from the Sunday gathering to worship the Lord at Mass. The streaming liturgies can be a helpful supplement to our spiritual life but are in no way a replacement for being present in person. Just as we believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, we also believe in the necessity of our "real presence" in the Body of Christ gathered as the Church!

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Oratory of St. Mary Magdalene is continuous with the exception of Mass at 5:30 pm on Fridays.



Click the hour you'd like to adore, select the frequency and then "sign up" (you may also request substitutes for times you can't make it to adoration at sainty.weadorehim.com).

USE OF INCENSE

Incense may be used at the 8:15 am Mass on Saturday. March 19, as we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Incense may be used at the 8:15 am Mass on Friday, March 25, as we celebrate The Annunciation of the Lord. We use an incense which is hypoallergenic.



As of this Sunday, the section previously roped off for social distancing (by the confessional area) during certain Masses will return to normal. If you have health concerns, you are encouraged to attend those Masses with fewer parishioners attending (5PM on Saturday, and 7AM and 5PM on Sunday).

Diocesan directives instruct that we should stay home (with Mass obligation lifted) if feeling unwell: "Anyone (whether vaccinated or not) with a cough or fever, or who may otherwise be feeling sick, should still remain home."

The 9 AM Sunday Mass will continue to be streamed on the parish website, on YouTube and on Facebook for those who cannot attend in person.

SCHOOL NEWS

Greetings in Christ! Especially in Lent, we continue to thank God for the many ways in which He is present in our community, showing his abundant grace. Last week, I reflected on many moving parts supporting one particular effort or event, and how in doing so, God's grace can be all the more abundant. In a related process, sometimes there are separate events that are not immediately connected, but reflect a similar theme of joy. This was true in this last week.

A family came in for a tour, looking at multiple grades, and they showed a particular joy to be at the school. Already in our Diocese, their family is moving, and so they are looking for a better commute and for their parish to be closer as well. They toured with Mrs. Zedaker, but in meeting them, they reflected to me how impressed they were at various offerings St. Vincent's has for students, and it reminded me how very blessed we are to be here. Not every school is able to offer the various supports we have - so this was a real grace to hear. Recently, COVID restrictions for our schools have greatly relaxed, and this allows for many renewed efforts to support students, from flexible groupings to the return of our true all Mass for grades K to 8, to field trips. Some of our parents were eager to meet to see about an 8th grade educational/ celebratory trip, as the last time this class could travel was in their 6th grade year. However, that year utilizes a spring trip, so this class last had a field trip as 5th graders. What a joy to see their parents seeking this opportunity for celebration and further education for their children!

I had been behind in meeting with one of our teachers to review supports for a student. Sometimes, the schedule can become a challenge for as timely follow up as I would want, and so when I went to review this with her, I apologized for that. Her response, in its genuineness, had something of God in it. She accepted the apology but said she was surprised that I would need to and hadn't really expected to hear from me, as other staff were already working to provide support with this. Now this is something really amazing about St. Vincent's. We really do work together for the good of our students, and it authentically happens that many staff at once contribute to the process, and that's where God was for me in that moment. Rather than, oh, I need to do something, this was God saying – I already have this, through our amazing staff.

Sometimes, the joy of the work comes with a new family touring. Other times, it is in families celebrating their student who will soon graduate, ending their time here but continuing to deepen their faith and discipleship with the Lord's next steps for them. Other times, it is in a teacher who finds the support for a student to be in abundance already, and other staff working together to achieve that, ahead of a principal being behind. This is all due of course to the glory of God at work in our school.

Let's make that the focus of this Lent. Matthew Kelly has pointed out in a few of his talks various habits we have that drain us of energy – complaining is a big one. Rather, intentional focus on the glory of God at work in our lives is something that provides new energy, or perhaps renewed energy in an area of our lives previously thought to be devoid of that grace. May we do exactly this, in this Lenten season – see, celebrate, and talk about the glory of God in our parish, in our school, in our daily lives.






