

# From Our Pastor



This Sunday marks the midpoint of Lent and is therefore called "Laetare Sunday," laetare being the Latin word meaning "to rejoice." I rejoice in particular at all of the Lenten initiatives for our growth in love of the Lord and each other taking place in these days, including the increased opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

If you weren't able to make it to the evening of Confessions at St. Vincent's last week, there will be another opportunity at St. Jude Parish this Monday, March 28 at 6:30PM, and the St. Vincent's Priests will be there.

This Thursday, March 31, Msgr. James Shea will speak to our Parish in the main church about the future of practicing our Catholic faith in the months and years ahead. He is the author of the book, *From Christendom* to Apostolic Mission: Pastoral Strategies for an Apostolic Age and one of the founders of the University of Mary in North Dakota. I consider the vision he lays out to be utterly decisive and abundantly fruitful for our following of Christ at St. Vincent's and pro-actively inviting others to discipleship in Him and for Him. 

Greetings in Christ! The Lord's presence in our community continues to give us many graces! One of those graces was a clear focus on Christian charity.

One of our students in the intermediate grades was really troubled about the horrible situation in the Ukraine. While we all likely feel this to some degree or another, she was motivated enough to act on this, and find a potential charity that focused on helping Ukrainian refugee children, and then wanted to present this to me. She hoped our school would do a \$1 out of uniform day, which we will do in the very near future. Her poise and presence in wanting to actually first pray, then find other meaningful action, and then being willing to present this to me, was truly an act of Christian charity and generosity, something so many of our families speak to and act on in very meaningful ways every day. Many of you will recall that Redeemer Radio held their Spring Shar-a-thon this past week. I was phenomenally blessed to be on with Debbie Blackburn, Lindsay Lushis, and Fr. Dan, and we had the opportunity to reflect on the many graces each of our respective ministries enact. You know what? We have some phenomenal people here, in both our parish and school—people who deeply love our Lord and find really creative and engaging ways of sharing that love. In sharing that, we of course also asked listeners to call in and support Redeemer Radio, and here again Christian charity was abundant. Our community was so generous - thank you St. Vincent's!

In another way of considering charity, a non-monetary one, Fr. Jay has attended a training for priests who are more recently ordained throughout this year, along with many other newer priests in our Diocese, called Good Leaders. Good Shepherds. He's had many training days throughout this calendar year, and then invited myself, Scott Nguyen, Monica Aquilla, and Lindsay Lushis to join him for a training to other parish staff this past Friday. I admire his charity in finding the fruitfulness from these trainings, as well as the charity of our staff colleagues who really worked together to reflect on principles we were covering as they impact our own lives as parish staff.

One aspect of Lent, the historical practice of almsgiving, is really a question of charity. Charity, at its root level, is a choice - one way of living out the greatest commandments. Will I love the Lord with everything that I have, will I love my neighbors in the same way? A charitable response is one that is willing to sacrifice one's own time, or treasure or talent, for the good of the other. That's a central question in Lent – can we sacrifice for the good of the other – a central question too of the entire Christian faith. This week, let's ask the Lord for the grace to answer this with an abundant ves.
