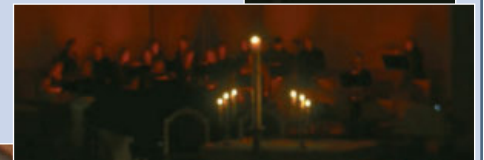
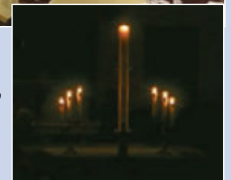

From Our Pastor



As we enter our third week of celebrating the Easter season, St. John's Gospel recounts to us the three-fold redemptive healing of St. Peter's shepherding mission after his three-fold denial of Christ in His Passion. Three times, the Risen Lord Jesus both sovereignly evokes and infallibly confirms St. Peter's loving profession of faith, culminating in the Apostles abiding declaration: "Lord, You know everything; You know that I love You!"

Congratulations to our eighth graders, who received earlier this weekend the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Rhoades when he came to St. Vincent's Saturday morning. If Baptism bestows the grace of membership, Confirmation confers the seed of one's adult mission, the form that one's life-long gift of self will take in the Church, for the life of the world—our eighth graders are now witnesses of these things!

SCHOOL NEWS

Fellow Parishioners, 05/01/22

One particular Mass in the Octave of Easter, and some graces from it, worked to show me something of the Lord's presence with us - that our community is in fact a conduit of His grace.

On the Friday of the Octave of Easter, one of the most powerful experiences of the school's all Mass was present (and it is a great joy to have our families and many parishioners with us for these Masses). Fr. Jay's preaching was particularly charged and inspiring - he called us to pray, seek an encounter with Christ in the sacraments, and, when we need the Lord's wisdom in our daily life after doing these things, pray "come, Holy Spirit!" and the Lord will clearly be with us. Our servers were particularly prayerful and reverent as one young man especially showed great respect for the Lord as our thurifer - his solemn and precise use of incense spoke of a maturity beyond his years. Our jr. high choir was perhaps more on fire with the Holy Spirit than ever in their praise and worship music. The full choir's actual spirit of praise was abundant, and their technical precision was exceptional. They had 4-5 student instrumentalists and one staff member on violin (they were ALL awesome). This included a young man on drums, another young man on piano/a different drum set, a young lady on piano, and a young man on guitar.

Also, the song selections included many soloists who showed tremendous courage and vocal skill in their parts. As one would finish, her friends would show a very tiny, appropriate gesture of support - like a small bump or just brilliant smiles. There was a holiness in seeing how they all supported one another for their solos! Fr. Jay was so moved that, as part of his prayer, when he wasn't actively distributing communion, he was humming the songs, with great joy and thanksgiving. I especially applaud the incredible joy and witness of our directors, Mrs. Proulx and Mrs. Nees, who lovingly work so hard to train and rehearse with our students - they achieved something incredible for God's kingdom in this! In addition, I couldn't help but notice one of our beloved teachers helping a student receive communion in that Mass, who had needed that particular support. This was such a clear example of Christ's love enfolding our young people.

Clearly my words can't do this Mass justice, but it was a powerful experience of the presence of God's Spirit. And in that Spirit, God's Holy Spirit, something truly did touch the hearts of our staff. I received at least a dozen either emails or in-person testaments from staff that same day as to how much they found God in that Mass. So in the gift of the Mass, it inspired an authentic and abundant outpouring of gratitude for the beauty it held.

It's important in our Christian faith, deeply so, to actually see the blessings the Lord puts in front of us, and to then celebrate those moments of beauty for what they are - direct gifts of God's grace. As the psalmist says, "I believe I shall see the Lord's goodness in the land of the living" (Ps 27:13). Amen! This week, if you can't get to an all Mass, they are live-streamed (8:15 on Fridays). This particular choir has an abundance of participants from our 8th grade class, and so they only have a few performances left. If you're in need of a blessing this week, come, join us!

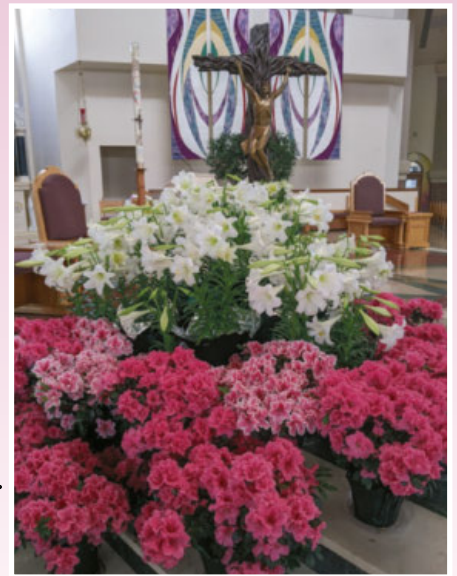

(That is, from Easter Day through Pentecost, the seventh Sunday after Easter). The Regina caeli is also said in place of the Angelus during Eastertide.

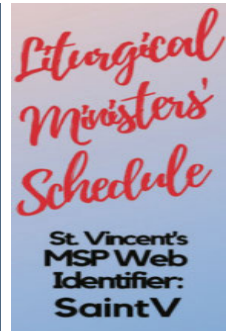
