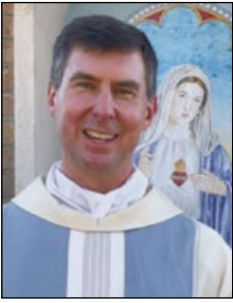

From Our Pastor



As we enter our fourth week of the Easter season, we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, which takes its name from Christ's revelation in today's Gospel of Himself as the Good Shepherd described in Psalm 23.

This Sunday we also celebrate the remainder of our second graders making their First Holy Communion. Their reception of the Body and Blood of the Lord for the first time is an infinite blessing of Christ's mercy not only on the entirety of their lives but on the lives of the past and future generations of their families. The gift they receive with such simple and open love should renew our own boundless gratitude for this immeasurably great Gift of God.

Last Saturday, Bishop Rhoades came to St. Vincent's to call down the Holy Spirit on our eighth graders in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Bishop will also be coming back to St. Vincent's to speak at our Armor of God men's movement on Wednesday, May 18 at 6:45PM. All men—young and old—are urged to join us around the Shepherd Christ has given us as the successor of the Apostles for our Diocese. Bishop Rhoades will be speaking about growth in virtue, sharpening and deepening those interior powers which perfect us. More information about this

Finally, as the letter from Tony and Marie Andorfer in this bulletin indicates, in June they will be moving from St. Vincent's to be closer to family and the care of their grandchild in Michigan. For decades, Tony and Marie have poured out their lives unreservedly in loving service of our music ministry, in addition to Marie's further behind-the-scenes work in the parish office (most recently as the bulletin coordinator and my administrative assistant).

In the next few weeks, we'll have the opportunity to express our gratitude to Tony and Marie for the immensity of their contribution to the liturgical prayer at the very heart of our Parish life. For now, I ask everyone to pray fervently and insistently to the Holy Spirit of the Risen Lord to send to us at St. Vincent's exactly the person(s) we need to lead our music program into the next season of our Parish's history. My prayer as Pastor is always, "Lord, send me the people we need to do what You want done." If you know anyone within or beyond our Diocese who might be an excellent fit for our music program, please direct them to send a resume to my attention through the parish office. SCHOOL NEWS

Fellow Parishioners, 05/08/22
 One joy in the ministry I am blessed with, and the ministry all our staff shares in, is seeing an intentionality of discipleship in our community. In our climate, we seek our Lord Jesus actively, passionately, and reflectively. In doing that, I find myself continually blessed with any number of witnesses or conversations that live this.

I saw Fr. Dan for a moment before our Confirmation Mass, when Bishop Rhoades confirmed 114 8th graders (INCREDIBLE by the way, glory be to God!). I said hello and asked how he was doing. In about a 60 second window, he shared that he was joyful, that he got to witness the candidate and sponsor coming forward, but with them his or her confirmation saint coming up too. Father Dan deeply believes this and in his faith, he “sees” this reality unfolding. Perhaps we may not realize the depth of faith and love our own shepherd here leads us with – faith and love shared by our priests. We need this witness – it is profoundly good! In that Mass, it happened that two of our teachers, both of whom are music leaders, helped sing/cantor, one whose daughter was receiving the sacrament, and the other who served as a sponsor for a student. Two other of our incredible teachers sponsored students as well – and here again, there is a witness that is profoundly good.

Mrs. Lushis, Mrs. Torres, Ms. Matty, and Mrs. Franzen did a phenomenal job of helping organize the day and running a day of reflection/retreat on the day before – many of our 8th grade students told me how much they loved this day!

Mr. Andorfer and Ms. Hayes contributed their leadership to the Mass as well. All of this added a greater beauty to the goodness of this witness, of this discipleship.

Before the Mass, one of our school dads, sponsoring an 8th grader, shared with me how the Lord helped lead him to his wife back when they were dating. It was a great story! This too showed me our discipleship, and his joy was indeed a clear moment of God’s presence. When the Mass ended, I had a moment of prayer in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.

One of our recently confirmed 8th graders walked in with her family, who wanted to pray together there and get a photo as well – again, such witness to our joy in Christ! What a gift that I happened to be there to share it!

The weekend before, 80 of our 2nd graders made their First Communion (again, INCREDIBLE, glory be to God)! As happened for Confirmation, here too, one of our front office staff led the music ministry for that Mass for her daughter receiving her First Communion. I found out later that her oldest daughter was also singing for that Mass for her younger sister. Again, this witness too is profoundly good. (By the way, at least 30 other 2nd graders will make First Communion the weekend you read this, and some dozens also made theirs in the Masses last weekend – amazing!)

Shortly before these Masses, in school Masses preparing our students for these sacraments, Fr. Dan made a comment about the Christian journey – we are to carry beauty into unexpected places. This is one way of wording the entire Christian calling, and it’s one way of answering a question I’ve been praying over these last weeks – what can we do to increase our own hope? – the quantity of much hope we approach each day with? One answer to that is that simple and that challenging – to carry beauty into unexpected places. One of the graces of St. Vincent’s is that we find so many opportunities to live this. So. Many! Glory be to God!

40 HOURS OF ADORATION FOR DEACON BRIAN ISENBARGER

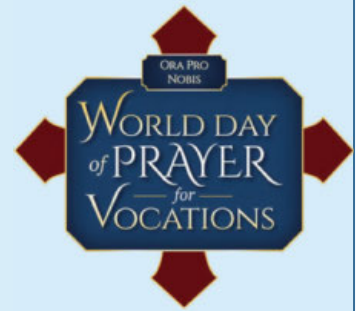

TRAINING FOR EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS FOR MASSES AND HOMEBOUND AND TO ASSIST WITH DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION AT PARKVIEW

We are now accepting names of persons who would like to be an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion at Masses at St. Vincent's or to the homebound. If you are interested or can recommend someone, please call the Church Office (260-489-3537 ext. 3) no later than May 15. Training will be on Wednesday, May 18 at 6:00 pm. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must be registered members of the parish for at least six months, over age 16, a Catholic in good standing with the Church, and a person with a good reputation in the community. It is assumed, of course, that the candidate has a love for our Lord in the Eucharist and a desire to deepen this love through this beautiful ministry. We ask you to recommend a man or woman of the parish, or you may submit your own name.

If you have a desire to help with distribution of Holy Communion at Parkview Regional Medical Center and have not yet been trained, please contact the Church Office (260-489-3537 ext. 3) prior to May 15. IF you are already commissioned as an Extraordinary Minister and would like to help at Parkview, please let us know. Parkview requires all Ministers to attend a brief training on volunteer protocol before starting there.
