# O FELIX CULPA A Word from our Pastor | 3

Who can you trust these days? The information we get through news outlets, respectable internet resources, even agencies entrusted with delivering to the public objective data all seem to be subject to scrutiny if not suspicion for their authenticity. There has been a prevalence of "fake news," and libelous claims are sometimes given as much press as genuine information. We are increasingly in the habit of second-guessing the trustworthiness of what we hear from the media. In addition to all this, so many words hurled by public figures at their adversaries are malicious, that the climate in our discourse about public matters always seems to be acrid.

St. Francis de Sales: pray for us! Tomorrow, January 24, the Church honors the patron saint of journalists. St. Francis' teaching and example are two things we could well use these days. Francis was ordained a priest in 1593 and eventually became the bishop of Geneva in 1602. This Swiss city at the time was very much in the control of the Calvinists. Intolerance for Catholics was extremely high, and Francis' life was often threatened. In

fact, he had to rule his diocese from the city of Annecy in France.

Francis de Sales Patron Saint of Journalists

"He who unjustly takes away his neighbor's good name is guilty of sin, ... and of all worldly possessions the most precious is a good name. Slander is a kind of murder; for we all have three lives – a spiritual life, which depends upon the Grace of God; a bodily life, depending on the soul; and a civil life, consisting in a good reputation. Sin deprives us of the first, death of the second, and slander of the third."

During this period of the Reformation, literacy and the new printing press were having an enormous impact on the public's base of knowledge. Francis used the latest intellectual tools available to him in his mission of evangelization. He dedicated his life to bringing many Catholics who had left the Church back into the fold. One of his most important tools was writing. Through letters and written sermons distributed door-to-door, Francis helped to persuade thousands to return to Catholicism. His most famous book is the *Introduction to the Devout Life*, aimed almost exclusively to lay men and women. It was St. Francis de Sales who gave us the popular sentiment about effectively winning over people: "A spoonful of honey

attracts more flies than a barrel full of vinegar." The quotations from his book on this page expands on this counsel, giving advice about how we are to speak of others.

While few of us are professional journalists, many of us, thanks to modern social media, are publishers by way of what we post on Facebook, tweet or text, or circulate in an email. We too disseminate information. Once our words go public, they're subject to interpretation by the readers. Handling this powerful faculty should be accompanied by good moral judgment. St. Francis de Sales reminds us of our responsibility to be servants to the truth. It should be an expectation we have not only of public figures but of ourselves as well.

"Let your words be kindly, frank, sincere, straightforward, simple and true; avoid all artifice, duplicity and pretense, remembering that, although it is not always well to publish abroad everything that may be true, yet it is never allowable to oppose the truth. Make it your rule never knowingly to say what is not strictly true, either accusing or excusing, always remembering that God is the God of Truth."

# FATHER ARCHER'S BOOK COLUMN

Time for God by Jacques Philippe

Where do you turn when you need a reminder of how delightful prayer can be? Father Jacques Philippe is a font of simple yet profound wisdom for the spiritual life. I first read *Time for God* in college, and it changed the way I



viewed prayer from something-I-have-to-do to my-sourceof-joy. In his accessible writing style, he distills the greatest insights of the saints to present an easy yet profound understanding of what prayer is and how to pray.

You will often hear me (and others) suggest "Perhaps you should pray about that," which is a frustrating recommendation if you are not quite certain what it means to pray. This book can guide you into making prayer accessible, easy, and delightful. He first describes what prayer is, then moves to giving suggestions for how you might use your time in quiet prayer, how prayer develops and deepens, and finishes with practical suggestions for different methods of prayer. Earlier this year, I purchased the set of Jacques Philippe books and put them in the back of the Adoration Chapel (under the sign-in sheet). Feel free to borrow them!

I leave you with his words: "I would like to pray, but I don't have the time.' This is an often-heard excuse. In a world that is overwhelmed with activity, there is real difficulty finding time for everything. Nevertheless, time is not the real problem but recognizing what matters most in life. One contemporary author observed, no one ever died of hunger because of not having time to eat." Pick up this book, and you will certainly learn how to better nourish your soul. Blessings!
