

HONOR THY CHILDREN

Last month in Frankfort, Gov. Andy Beshear signed into law House Bill 254 that increased the penalty for possessing, viewing, or wantonly distributing matter portraying a sexual performance by a minor under the age of 12 years to a Class C felony. The measure was brought forth by Rep. Derek Lewis of London. Under this provision, first offenders will be charged with a Class C felony, and a Class B felony for each subsequent offense.

"As a father, this issue is particularly meaningful because we know that child sexual abuse exists in epidemic proportions. These materials normalize sick, inhumane acts, further victimize young children, and cause irreparable harm to our most vulnerable," Lewis said. "It is high time we stepped up to provide law enforcement with more resources."

THIS WEEK'S QUESTION

- Q. Why was Bible study not encouraged among Catholics until recent times?
- A. First of all, before the invention of the printing press, the Bible had to be copied by hand. Furthermore, most people were illiterate in those times. Then in more recent years, the Catholic Church saw how Protestant denominations were coming up with various interpretations of what the Bible scripture verses meant; therefore, in order to avoid conflict among Catholics, they just expected parishioners to hear the scriptures read at Mass; then the priest would explain what it meant. Catholic schools half a century ago were cheaper (hence, more available) and much more religious-based, so children learned the basic Catholic teachings based on the Bible at school. Most families had a Bible in their home, although it was rarely read.

Today, Catholics who are faithful to the teaching of the Church are totally into the Word. The level of education is higher than it has ever been, and people are better able to comprehend its meaning. Regular private scripture is a blessing to all Catholics who read the Bible at least 15 minutes a day.
