### RESPECT FOR LIFE

"Once admit the right to kill unproductive persons ... then none of us can be sure of his life." So spoke Cardinal Clemens von Galen of Munster, Germany, in 1941. This Cardinal was called the "Lion of Munster" because he roared with the voice of the Gospel against the atrocities of the Nazi Regime.

On October 9, 2005, he was beatified at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. During his life, the Cardinal protested with special force against euthanasia.

"The opinion is that since they (the old) can no longer make money, they are obsolete machines, comparable with some old cows that can no longer give milk or a horse that has gone lame. Here we are dealing with human beings, with our neighbors, brothers and sisters, the poor and the invalids – unproductive, perhaps. But have they, therefore, lost the right to live? Have you or I the right to exist only because we are productive?" (August 3, 1941)

### FAMILY MOMENTS

**Marriage Moments:** What can a tree teach you about marriage? "It shall put forth branches and bear fruit." (Ezekiel 17:23) Some trees grow naturally. Some need pruning to become their best selves. Can you spend some time together today enjoying and learning from a tree?

**Parenting Pointers:** "While they were eating ... Jesus said the blessing." (Mark 14:22) What happens when your family eats together? Presumably, you start with a blessing of the food, but what happens during the meal? You may recount the day, there may be laughter, or complaining. Hopefully, there are no phones present. Let it be a time to be present to each other.

## The Body and Blood of Christ

### STEWARDSHIP

"While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, and said, 'Take it; this is my body.' Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, 'This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many.'" Mark 14:22-24

The Eucharist illustrates the ultimate model of stewardship: the sharing of God's very self with all who seek him.

## ASK FR. CHRISTIAN

- Q. I have a prayer card to St. Anthony that, in part, says, “... whisper my petition into the ears of the Sweet Infant Jesus, who loved to be folded in your arms ...” Did St. Anthony live in the time of Christ, and did he really hold Baby Jesus in his arms?
- A. St. Anthony lived from 1195 to 1231 AD. So, no, he did not actually hold Baby Jesus in his arms. However, he has more miracles attributed to him than almost any other saint, and Anthony loved the Infant Jesus dearly. Among the miracles is the fact that many people who encountered Anthony in person would see a “vision” of him holding Baby Jesus.

Anthony was from a wealthy Portuguese family and joined the Augustinian priesthood at age 15. Years later, he decided to change his affiliation to the Franciscan priests, where he reported directly to his superior, St. Francis. He was sent to the Middle East, where he preached to Muslims. He battled health issues since being a young man and became ill at the age of 35, when he died. He was canonized a year later by Pope Gregory IX.
