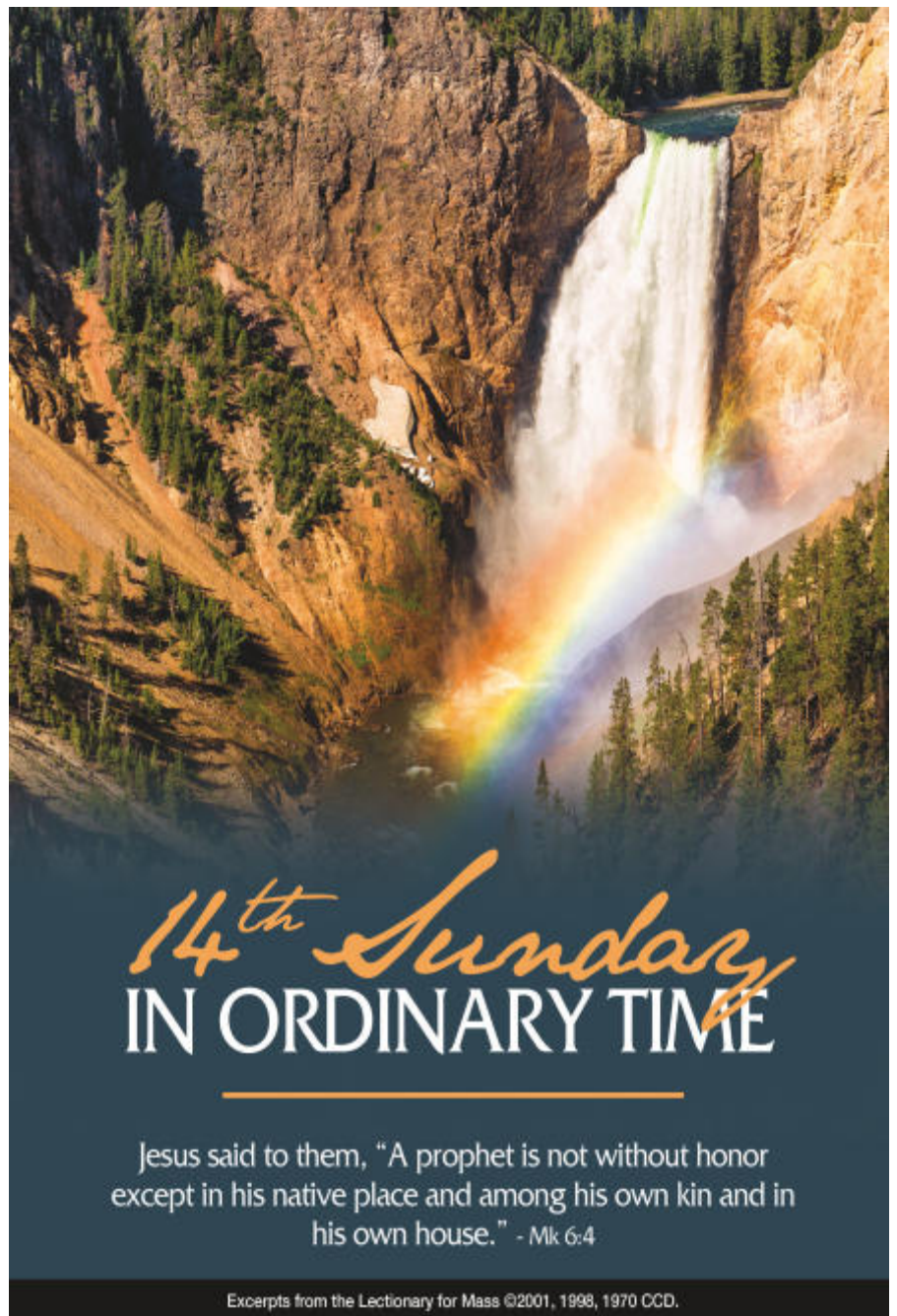

ASK FR. CHRISTIAN

- Q. Why is Jesus sometimes called the “Son of David?”
- A. King David is one of the most important people in Jewish history and was born about 1,000 years before Christ. But that reference simply points out Jesus’ lineage; Jesus Christ had Israel’s most-loved king as His human ancestor. Another reason why Jesus was called that way is because it’s a title for the promised Messiah, the Righteous King who will rule over God’s people in victory over the enemy. God promised David that the Messiah would be his Descendant.

Like David, Jesus was bent on doing everything that pleased God. He is a Man after God’s own heart, just like David was. Before David became king, he was a mere shepherd boy who took care of his father’s sheep. Jesus Christ Himself is the Great Shepherd who takes care of His Father’s sheep — us!

HONOR THY CHILDREN

Many years ago, a mother and 18-month old daughter, Lily, who was strapped in her car seat landed upside down in a river in Utah for 14 hours. The mother was killed. A fisherman discovered the wreck, and firemen were notified.
