MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP KURTZ

Fall, 2021

The following guidelines are in effect immediately unless there is a new, serious development. You will be notified if that occurs.

1. Catholics are obligated to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, unless:
 - a. You are ill or caring for others who are ill
 - b. You have a serious health concern about exposure to Covid
 - c. You are unable to get vaccinated
2. Viewing the Mass online, when one is otherwise able to attend in person, does not constitute participation in the Mass and does not fulfill the obligation to attend Mass.
3. The directives stated in #1 above extend to all liturgies and events/meetings held on parish property, including, but not limited to, funerals, weddings, Eucharistic adoration, meetings of parish staff and committees, formation programs, etc.
4. Pastors and their staff will continue reaching out to parishioners who are unable to attend Mass, to visit them, and to make sacraments available to them if possible.
5. The wearing of masks is optional for fully vaccinated people.
6. Those who are not fully vaccinated are required to wear masks indoors for liturgies and other parish functions.
7. Masks also are required at programming involving children unable to be vaccinated, such as parish religious education programs.

THIS WEEK'S QUESTION

Q. Is there a contradiction between science and faith?

A. Many of the greatest scientists in history, such as Nicolas Copernicus, Isaac Newton, and Fr. George Lamaitre (Big Bang Theory) believed in God. The same God who created the universe revealed the Christian religion. If there is an apparent contradiction between science and religion, it means that we need to understand either our science or religion better. Catholics do not believe in a literalistic reading of Genesis. We accept the scientific finding regarding the age of the universe and the progression of simpler forms of life to more complex ones in the fossil records.

Science is limited in what it studies. It cannot tell us the ultimate source of creation, nor can it tell us the meaning and purpose of human life.
