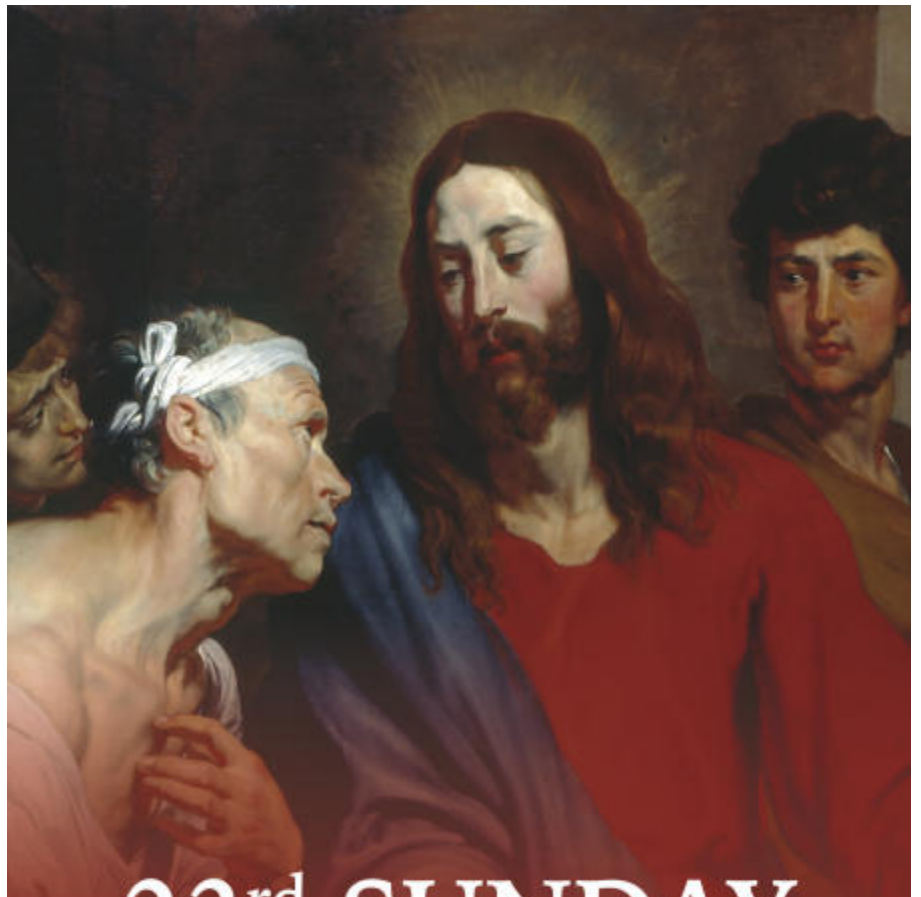

THIS WEEK'S QUESTION

Q. What is an annulment?

A. An annulment verifies that "the marriage never existed in a **sacramental sense**." It is the Church's colloquial term for the declaration of a "decree of nullity," a determination that a sacramental marriage did not take place on the wedding day of the couple in question because of an impediment prevented one or both parties from giving full consent to the marriage. Diocesan tribunals focus on the circumstances at the time of the wedding itself. Was it a "shotgun wedding" because of an unexpected pregnancy? Was the marriage coerced by physical or verbal violence? Did one partner hide an ongoing addiction from the spouse? Did both partners understand what was meant by the holy sacrament itself? Any and all this type evidence are valid causes for an annulment.

What an annulment is **NOT**: It is not a "Catholic divorce;" it is not a declaration that a marriage did not exist; it is not a declaration that the children of a Catholic marriage are illegitimate in the eyes of the Catholic Church. It just means that there was no sacramental component to the marriage and allows the spouses to remarry within the Church.

Per Fr. Christian, most of the requested annulments he has been involved with go through fine. Also, there is no cost to the person(s) requesting the annulment.
