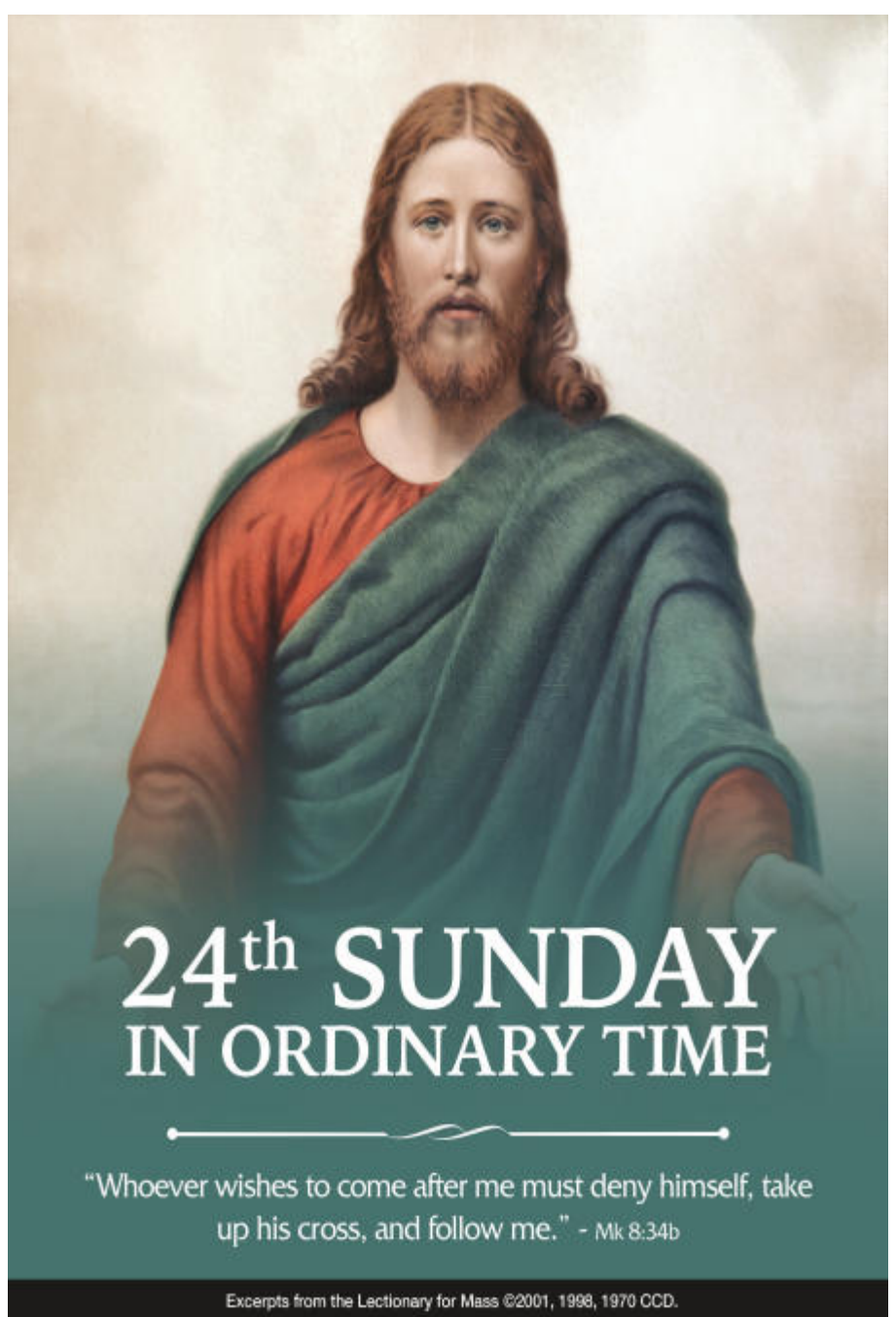

ASK FR. CHRISTIAN

Q. Why do some Franciscans wear sandals?

A. When Francis founded the Franciscan order in the 1200s, all the Franciscans went barefoot. Then it became the tradition over the centuries for the Franciscans to wear sandals. Different branches of the order had different customs about wearing sandals, but in more recent times, almost all the Franciscans have the option now whether or not to wear sandals. Keep in mind that Jesus and his Apostles wore sandals, as did everybody in Jesus' time. And this may have inspired the early Franciscans. Through the years, Franciscans did not wear socks with their sandals, even in the winter. I don't wear socks in warm weather, but I do in the winter. Of course, socks don't do much good in the snow!
